A Resolution Increasing the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Yolo County Office of Emergency Services Budget by \$280,000 for DWR funding of the Dry Well Assistance Program

**WHEREAS**, County's "Dry Well Assistance Program", has been identified as a priority project for emergency drought funding from the State Department of Water Resources' Small Community Drought Relief Program which approved funding of not to exceed amount of \$559,500 for the Yolo County Temporary Tank and Water Hauling Project with \$30,000 county cash match allocated on November 23, 2021 by Board action and \$65,628 in kind match of OES staff time; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated additional cost and state funding for the fiscal year of \$280,000 for the abovementioned program is not included in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Yolo County Office of Emergency Services Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 29125 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 as follows:
