

**ORDINANCE NO. 919.98**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE YOLO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1. Salary of each member of the Yolo ~~county~~ County Board of Supervisors** – Section 2 of Yolo County Ordinance No. 919 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) Beginning ~~June 11, 2017~~ June 11, 2022, the annual salary of each member of the Board of Supervisors shall be set at an amount equal to ~~thirty-five-forty seven and one-half~~ percent (~~3547.5~~%) of the annual salary paid to a judge of the Yolo County Superior Court as of that same date.
- (b) ~~Effective June 11, 2022 and with 15 days of notification of any enacted adjustment of the annual salary paid to a judge of the Yolo County Superior Court, Not later than June 1, 2004, and on June 1 of each year thereafter,~~ the County Administrative Officer shall determine, or cause to be determined, the amount of each Supervisor's salary increase or decrease, if any, which is to become applicable ~~on the following July 1. Supervisor salary increases or decreases will be implemented at the same time and in the same manner as adjustments to the annual salary paid to a judge of the Yolo Superior Court, including application of retroactive adjustments where applicable.~~ - Within fifteen calendar days following the determination of each Supervisor's salary, the County Administrative Officer shall file, or cause to be filed, with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a written certificate which identifies and includes the following:
- i. The then current annual salary of each member of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors.
  - ii. The amount of increase or decrease, if any, the State of California has made to the salaries of judges of the Yolo Superior Court since the application of the salary established initially by this Ordinance or since the previous determination by the County Administrative Officer of the salary of a member of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors, whichever is applicable; and
  - iii. The annual salary of each member of the Board of Supervisors following the adjustment necessary as a result of any adjustment to the salary of a judge of the Yolo Superior Court in order for the salary of each member of the Board of Supervisors to continue to be equal to ~~thirty-five-forty seven and one-half~~

percent (~~3547.5~~) of the salary of a judge of the Yolo Superior Court beginning ~~April 2~~ June 11, ~~2017~~2022; and:  
~~iii.~~iv. The amount of any retroactive adjustment, if applicable.

**SECTION 2. Effective Date/Publication.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on and after 60 days after its passage. Before the expiration of 15 days after passage of this Ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the Ordinance. This publication is to be made in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Yolo.
