**A RESOLUTION OF THE YOLO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR THE WALTER’S HOUSE RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, The California Department of Healthcare Services (“DHCS”) was authorized through legislation in 2021 to establish the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (“BHCIP”); and

**WHEREAS**, Friends of the Mission is a nonprofit public benefit corporation eligible to apply for funding under the BHCIP; and

**WHEREAS**, Walter’s House is a substance abuse treatment center currently located in downtown Woodland; and

**WHEREAS**, Friends of the Mission intends to submit a BHCIP funding application to support the relocation of Walter’s House Residential Treatment Program to East Beamer Way (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, it appears to be in the best interest of the County, its residents, and its clients to support DHCS funding for the Project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Yolo County Board of Supervisors supports the funding of the Project by DHCS.
