**Proclaiming April 3-9, 2022 as National Library Week**

**WHEREAS**, Yolo County Library connects people to technology, providing access to broadband internet, computers, and WiFi hotspots for educational, informational and employment opportunities;

**WHEREAS**, Yolo County Library encourages lifelong learning by offering Career Online High School, JobNow/VetNow and LinkedIn Learning for job seekers, and Books by Mail for the homebound;

**WHEREAS**, Yolo County Library partners with school districts to offer students automatic library cards with 24/7 access to ad-free, reliable research content, e-books and downloadable media via Sora;

**WHEREAS**, in times of crisis, Yolo County Library, library workers and volunteers play a valuable role in supporting communities both in person and virtually through community discussion forums, outreach events, and partnerships with local government and nonprofit organizations;

**WHEREAS**, Yolo County Library is expanding its resources to meet the evolving needs of its patrons;

**WHEREAS**, Yolo County Library unites with libraries and library workers, supporters and advocates across the nation to celebrate National Library Week.
