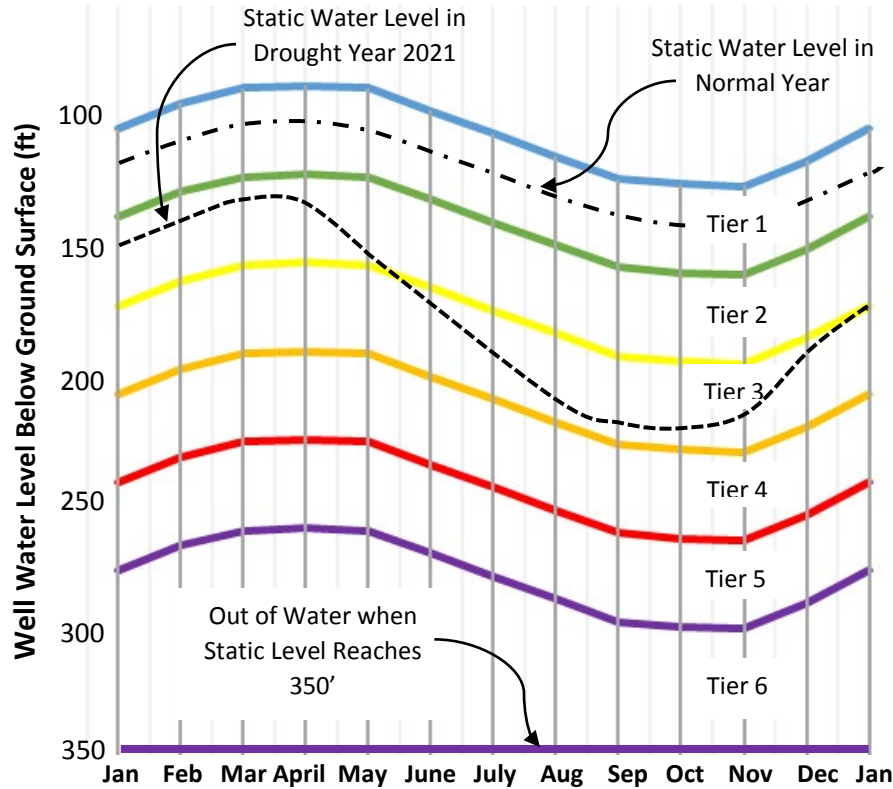

Tier Level	Water Use Cut (1)	Key Conservation Measures - Refer to Ordinance for all Measures (2)
1		Only incidental irrigation runoff allowed No irrigation from 9 am-6 pm except w/handheld hose w/shutoff No irrigation within 48 hrs. of rain No irrigation of turf on public street medians May irrigate community play areas Car washing only w/hose equipped w/shutoff nozzle No washing driveways and sidewalks except for health & safety Fix water leaks within 72 hours
2	20%	Level 1 restrictions except where replaced w/the following Irrigate max of 3 assigned days/wk (except drip systems) 12 minutes/station/day (except drip & rotor systems) No car washing at home (use commercial carwash)
3	30%	Irrigate max of 2 assigned days/wk (except drip systems) No new turf installation, only new drought tolerant plants & trees Repair all water leaks within 48 hrs (3 & 4)
4	40%	No landscape irrigation except for trees & drought tolerant plants Fill pools & tanks with hauled water from outside of community Repair all water leaks within 24 hrs (5)
5	50%	Level 1, 2, 3, & 4 restrictions except where replaced w/below No new pools may be installed No new landscaping or landscaping renovations
6	>50%	Level 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5 restrictions except where replaced w/below Stop all water to landscaping except for: Fire protection, rare plants or plants needed by rare animals, Ok to water public parks & playing fields
		OUT OF WATER Office of Emergency Services Sends Truck to Deliver Bottled Water & Water in 5-Gallon Buckets for Community

- Reduction in water use is compared to 2019 when Wildwings used 85 MG
- Refer to Yolo County Ordinance for complete text of conservation measures
- Stop filling of ornamental ponds except the amount needed to keep wildlife alive
- Tier 1 & 2 restrictions apply except where replaced with the items listed for Tier 3.
- Tier 1, 2, & 3 restrictions apply except where replaced with the items listed for Tier 4.
