WHEREAS, Kelly Ratliff has served as a trusted leader in multiple positions at UC Davis over the past thirty-five years, including Chief Budget Officer, Associate Vice Chancellor for Budget and Instructional Analysis, Senior Associate Vice Chancellor of Finance and Resource Management, and Vice Chancellor of Finance, Operations and Administration; and

WHEREAS, Kelly's guidance in creating the UC Davis Long Range Development Plan and a number of collaborative activities to nurture the partnership between the University, the City of Davis, and Yolo County helped to improve the town-gown relationship; and
