A Resolution Increasing the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 County Administrator’s Water Resources Division Budget by \$25,000 for Emergency Drought Grant Writing Services

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2021, the Board of Supervisors approved a \$50,000 work authorization with Consero Solutions for grant writing assistance for the purpose of identifying, compiling, and submitting local water, wastewater, and groundwater recharge projects for emergency drought funding available from the state and federal government; and

WHEREAS, an amended work authorization for an additional \$25,000 of services by Consero Solutions is needed for additional drought related grant writing and project management services to be funded by general fund contingency; and

WHEREAS, the abovementioned amended work authorization cost and funding is not included in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 County Administrator’s Water Resources Division Budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 29125 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 as follows:
