**PROCLAIMING MAY 30, 2022 (MEMORIAL DAY) IN YOLO COUNTY AS THE  
OFFICIAL OBSERVANCE OF THE SACRIFICES OF ALL VETERANS  
WHO HAVE SERVED OUR COUNTRY**

**WHEREAS**, Memorial Day had its beginning in 1866 when memorial associations were formed for the purpose of caring for the graves of soldiers who died during the Civil War; and

**WHEREAS**, Memorial Day has evolved into a national holiday whereby Americans, our elected officials and veterans' service organizations celebrate with patriotic and memorial ceremonies at monuments and cemeteries throughout this great nation and here in Yolo County; and
