**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-23
FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017
THROUGH THE ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Yolo County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County will receive an estimated \$5,457,341 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2022-2023 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the 6th year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County has undergone a public process to allow for public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to help develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County rehabilitate 60.4 miles of roads, throughout the County this year and hundreds of miles of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in an "at-risk" condition and this revenue will help

the County increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a “good” condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, rehabilitation of road infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED, AND FOUND by the Board of Supervisors of Yolo County, State of California, as follows:
