Resolution Adjusting Appropriations in the Sheriff's Management Budget, for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the Amount of \$63,666

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has identified a need for additional equipment items to conduct its law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office now wishes to purchase a Computer Voice Stress Analyzer (CVSA) to aid in the administration of background investigations for potential new employees; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office also wishes to purchase a High-Resolution Thermal Drone already approved and added to the Authorized Equipment List on March 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests \$63,666 in management expenditure savings to be moved from major object Services and Supplies to major object Equipment for Fiscal Year 2021-22 for these purchases; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General Fund for Fiscal Year 2021-22 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 as follows:
