RESOLUTION NO. 22-01

(Resolution Approving Biennial Audit)

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Clarksburg Fire Protection District to manage the revenue and capital assets of the District; and

WHEREAS, a biennial audit, as opposed to yearly audits, would decrease District expenses for professional services; and

WHEREAS, review of past audits has not disclosed any accounting or management deficiencies; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 26909 provides in relevant part:

(b) A special district may, by unanimous request of the governing board of the special district and with unanimous approval of the board of supervisors, replace the annual audit required by this section with one of the following, performed in accordance with professional standards, as determined by the county auditor:

(1) A biennial audit covering a two-year period.

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interests of the District, its residents, taxpayers and other customers, to shift from annual to biennial audits.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Clarksburg Fire Protection District, as follows:

The required audit of the books of account of the Clarksburg Fire Protection District shall, subject to the unanimous approval of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors, proceed on a biennial basis.


