Commending Kim Weisenburg Upon her Retirement from Yolo County

WHEREAS, beginning September 19, 1986, Kim Weisenburg began her career in the Clerk-Recorder's Office as a Typist Clerk; and

WHEREAS, throughout her county career Kim has demonstrated outstanding and dedicated customer service to the residents of Yolo County and was promoted accordingly to Admin Clerk in March 1987 (reclassified as Recordable Document Examiner), Clerk-Recorder Support Specialist in September 1995, Supervising Clerk-Recorder Support Specialist in November 2003, Assistant Clerk-Recorder in August 2009, and Managing Deputy Clerk-Recorder in September 2017; and

WHEREAS, through hard work and determination, Kim succeeded in learning both the Clerk and Recorder functions and received her Recordable Document Examiner certificate in 1990 from the Recorder's Association; and

WHEREAS, during her tenure with the Clerk-Recorder's Office, Kim served as a Marriage Commissioner and worked directly with the State Health Department on the same sex marriage forms for Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, Kim assisted in several important implementations within the Clerk-Recorder's Office; including, the first automated recording system in Yolo County, conversion of microfilm images to electronic images, Eagle Recorder and e-Recording systems; and

WHEREAS, Kim was passionate about the challenge of interpreting government code and greatly enjoyed working with all of the Clerk-Recorder staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors extends its congratulations and best wishes to Kim Weisenburg for her 36 years of dedicated public service and wishes her a long, healthy, and happy retirement.
