

**AGREEMENT NO. 22-\_\_\_\_\_**

(First Amendment to the Agreement No. 17-202, dated June 27, 2017, between the County of Yolo and Yolo County Visitors Bureau, d.b.a. Visit Yolo)

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to Agreement No. 17-202 is entered into as of July 1, 2022 by and between the County of Yolo ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of California, and Yolo County Visitors Bureau, d.b.a. Visit Yolo, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation ("Contractor"), who agree as follows:

**RECITALS**

1. On June 27, 2017, the County's Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 17-89 establishing the Yolo County Tourism Business Improvement District ("District"), a business assessment district, pursuant to the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994 (Cal. Streets & Highways Code §§ 36600 et seq.) ("Act") that included the cities of Davis, Winters and Woodland and further approved a final management district plan for the District entitled the "Yolo County Tourism Improvement District Management District Plan" ("Plan").
2. The District was established for a five-year term commencing July 1, 2017 and ending on June 30, 2022.
3. The Act permits renewal of the District.
4. The County's Board of Supervisors adopted a Resolution of Intention, Resolution No. 22-51, (A Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo Declaring its Intention to Renew the YCTBID and Fixing the Time and Place of a Public Meeting and a Public Hearing Thereon and Giving Notice Thereof) on April 26, 2022.
5. On June 28, 2022, the Board of Supervisors held a final public hearing regarding the renewal of the District and adopted a Resolution of Formation renewing the District for a seven year period beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2029 ("Renewal Term") and approving Agreement No. 17-202 with Visit Yolo with a term of July 1, 2017-June 30, 2022.
6. The Resolution of Formation included approval of the updated District boundaries and adopted an updated Management District Plan, dated March 18, 2022 ("2022 Plan").
7. The 2022 Plan designates Contractor as the continued "owners' association" that will implement the programs and activities described in the 2022 Plan.
8. The parties wish to amend Agreement No. 17-202 to extend its term for the Renewal Term and update Exhibit A of the Agreement with the 2022 Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, County and Contractor mutually agree that Agreement No. 17-202 is hereby amended, effective July 1, 2022, as follows:

**FIRST AMENDMENT**

1. Section B of Agreement No. 17-202 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**B. TERM**

The Agreement term will commence on July 1, 2017 and expire on June 30, 2029 unless the Agreement term is amended or the Agreement is terminated in accordance with its terms.

2. Exhibit A of Agreement No. 17-202 is replaced in its entirety with the 2022 Plan attached hereto and all references to the "Plan" in Agreement No. 17-202 shall, effective July 1, 2022, refer to the 2022 Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.

3. Except as specifically amended herein, Agreement No. 17-202 shall remain in full force and effect according to its terms.
