LEGAL NOTICE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors will be conducting a public hearing on **Tuesday, July 26, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.** or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Yolo County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 625 Court St, Room 206, Woodland, California. Those wishing to appear may do so in-person or by participating using Zoom (including both video and dial-in options). Instructions for Zoom participation will be provided on the meeting agenda posted to the County website (www.yolocounty.org) and available for viewing outside of the County Administration Building located at 625 Court Street, Woodland, CA 95696 at least 72 hours in advance of the meeting to consider the item described below:

The County has exclusive franchise agreements with Waste Management and Recology (Franchisees) for solid waste services. Pursuant to Section 6-17.507 of the Yolo County Code titled “Delinquent Accounts; Liens” any account with unpaid charges for one year or longer is considered a delinquent account. At the request of a Waste Management and Recology, and upon submission to the County of appropriate information demonstrating that an account is delinquent, the County sends a letter to the owner of the property with the delinquent account and requests payment within 30 days. If complete payment is not received by the County within 30 days, the County places a lien on the property in accordance with Government Code Section 25828 and proceed to collect any unpaid amounts in the manner set forth therein. All delinquent amounts collected by the County are remitted in full to the Franchisee, less any offset for amounts due the County from the Franchisee.

A public hearing will be held to allow for those property owners with delinquent Waste Management or Recology accounts to address the Board of Supervisors prior to the attachment of a lien against their property. Anyone who wishes to comment on this matter may do so in advance by emailing clerkoftheboard@yolocounty.org or in person or via Zoom during the public hearing.
