Description of Scope and Charge of the Subcommittee: In coordination with staff (and outside agencies, if needed): (1) by August 30, recommend to the Board of Supervisors standard practices for notifying Supervisors of emergency events unfolding in the County and individual Districts; (2) by September 30, 2022, provide recommendations on the use of emergency notification systems to apprise the public of emergency events (e.g., wildfires, floods) and establish and document clear practices and processes in the use of these systems; and (3) bring final recommendations to the Board in time to ensure implementation no later than October 15, 2022.
