# Historic Importance

The barn was constructed in 1910 and owned by George H. Wilson from 1937 to 1950.

Lead sugar beet farmer in the nation and brought the sugar beet industry to Clarksburg with one of the most profitable plants in the U.S.

Served as President of Yolo County and California Farm Bureau and Director of the American Farm Bureau Federation for 20 years.

Appointed by Eisenhower to the Agricultural Trade Mission to Asia and established the School of International Studies at the College of the Pacific at Stockton.

# Recommended Action

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Review the Resolution from the Historic Landmark Commission;
2. Determine that a 'Common sense' exemption is the appropriate level of environmental documentation;
3. Approve a resolution amending the General Plan to add the Barn at Utter Ranch and update the location information for the list of County-designated Historic Landmarks.
