

**THIRD AMENDMENT
 (BOS AGREEMENT NO. ____ - ____)**

This Third Amendment to Agreement No. 21-194 (“Third Amendment”) is made and entered into as of the last date signed below, by and between the County of Yolo, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), and Yolo Wayfarer Center, dba Fourth and Hope, a non-profit corporation authorized to do business in the State of California (“Contractor”), jointly referred to as the “Parties” herein and who agree as follows.

WHEREAS, on or about August 31, 2021, the Parties entered into Agreement No. 21-194 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, on or about December 27, 2021, the Parties amended the Agreement via the First Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on or about May 10, 2022, the Parties further amended the Agreement via the Second Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Parties would now like to amend the Agreement, as previously amended to:

1. Revise the **SUBAWARD INFORMATION** to add funding in the amount of \$75,000 for a new contract maximum of \$386,485; and
2. Revise **Paragraph X.A. of Attachment 6** to update the contract budget and revise line-item amounts.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The **SUBAWARD INFORMATION** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:




