Honoring Undersheriff Dale Johnson upon his Retirement

WHEREAS, the calling for the law enforcement profession is one of the highest vocations of public service, and any individual who accepts this challenge is worthy of the utmost respect and honor the community, state, and nation can provide; and

WHEREAS, Dale Steven Johnson began his career with the Yolo County Sheriff's Office as a Deputy Sheriff on April 29, 1992; and

WHEREAS, as a Deputy Sheriff, Dale worked several assignments including Marine Patrol, Investigations, Patrol, and on January 22, 1995 was the first Deputy ever assigned to the Capay Augmented Patrol; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2000, Dale was promoted to the rank of Sergeant, and on August 14, 2011 he was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant, and on October 6, 2013 Dale was promoted to the rank of Captain; and

WHEREAS, Dale is one of the Yolo County Sheriff Office's most highly decorated members. During his career, Dale was named "Deputy of the Year" in 1995, received the Mother's Against Drunk Driving Award in May 2002, was part of the 2005 "Team of the Year" awarded to the Investigations Section, received a commendation for Dedicated Service in 2006, and was named the 2007 and 2010 "Sworn Manager of the Year"; and

WHEREAS, during his career, Dale was assigned as the Division Commander of each of the Sheriff Office's divisions, providing leadership to Field Operations, Detention, and Administration; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2019, Dale was appointed to serve as Undersheriff-Coroner under Sheriff Tom A. Lopez; and

WHEREAS, Undersheriff Johnson has established himself as one of the most well-respected members of the law enforcement profession, inasmuch as he demonstrated a high degree of professionalism; as well as the highest degree of care and compassion to all he served.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby thanks, commends and wishes to express its gratitude to Dale Johnson for his years of public service to Yolo County and wishes him a long, happy and healthy retirement.
