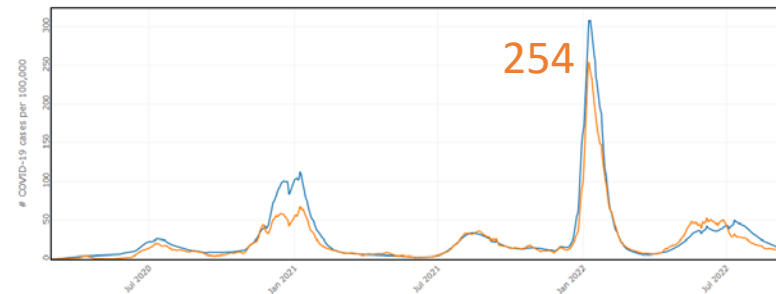
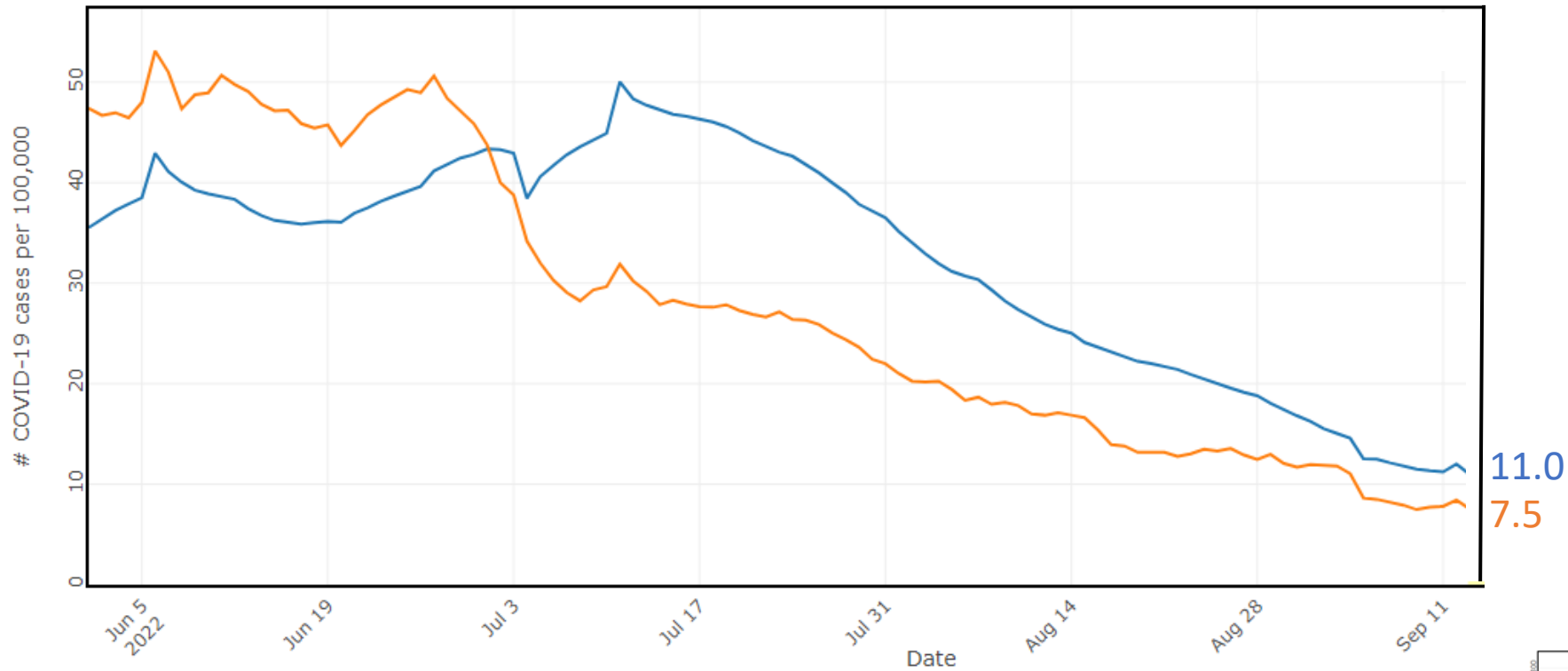


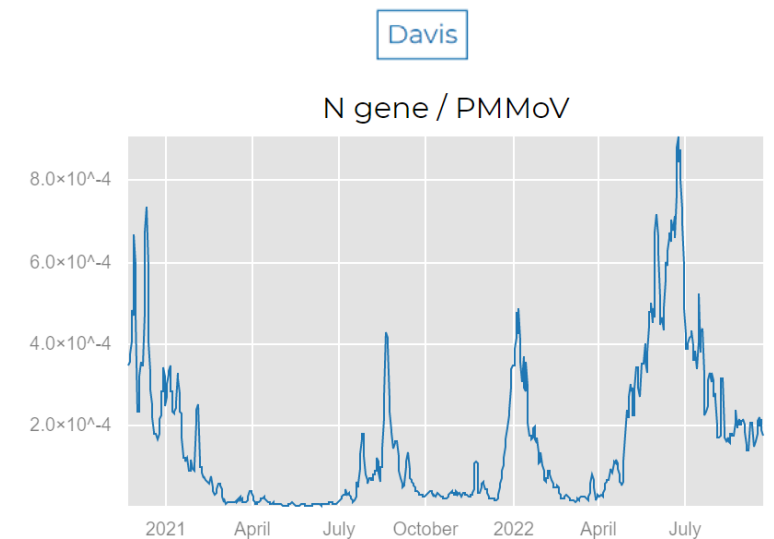
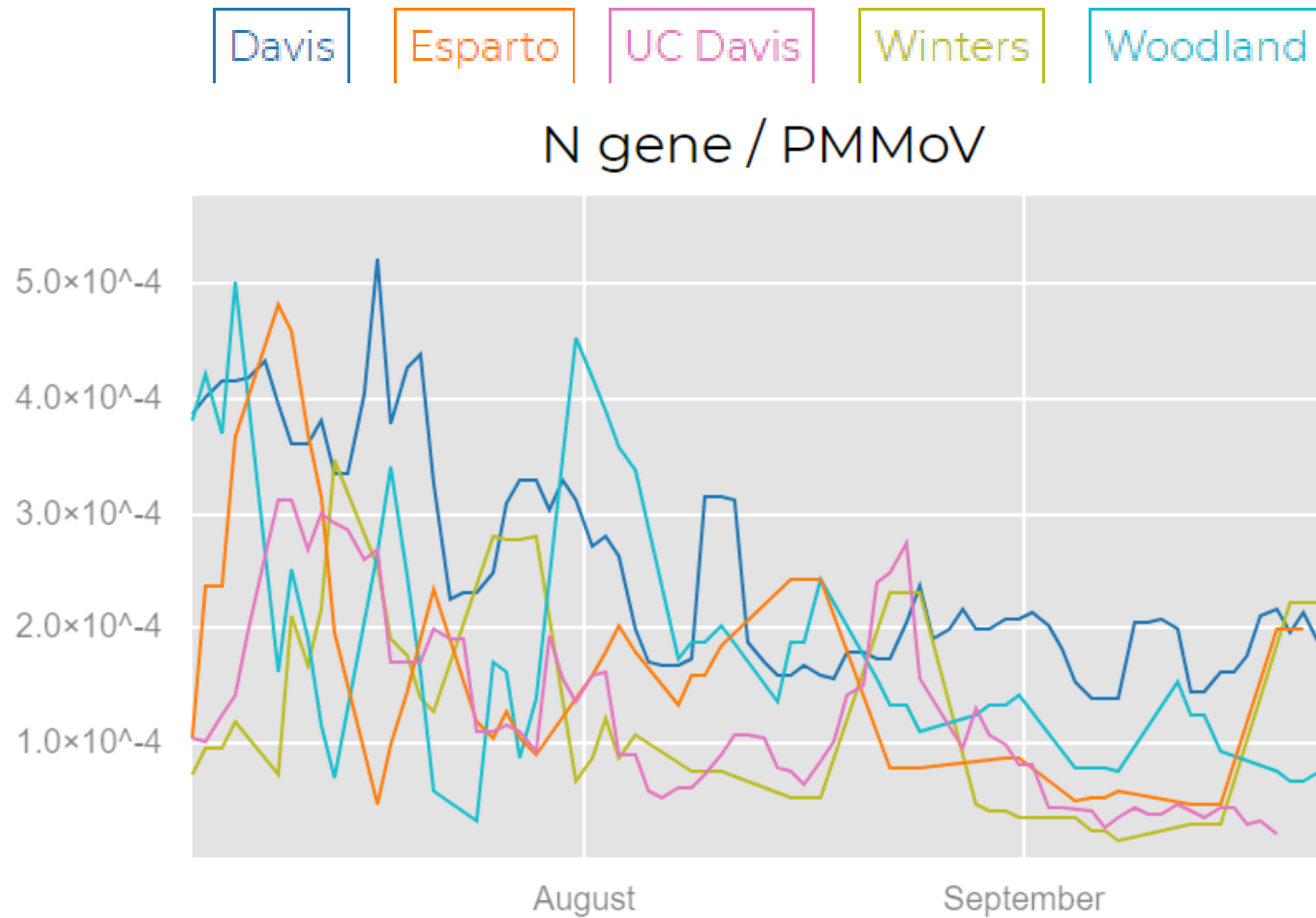
Yolo's COVID-19 case rate is decreasing.

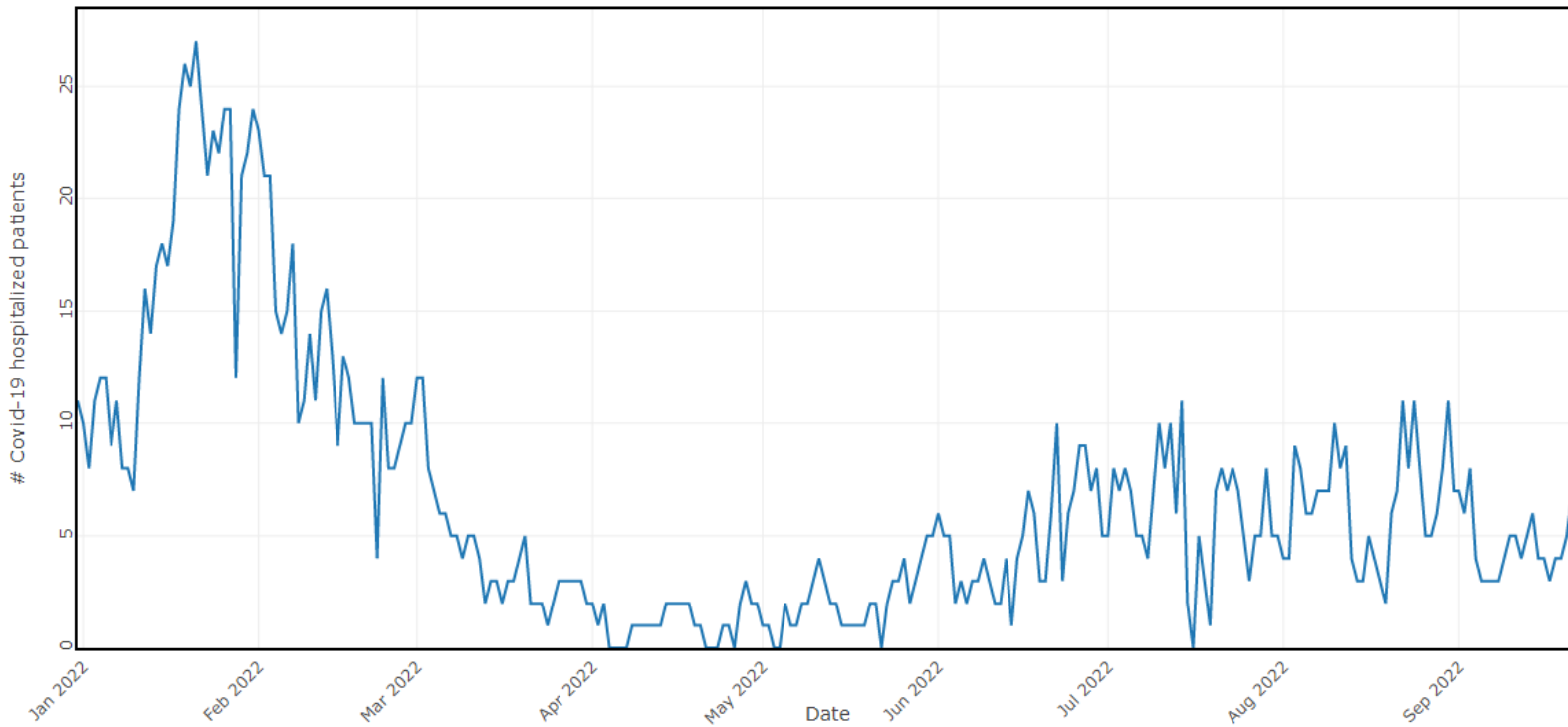

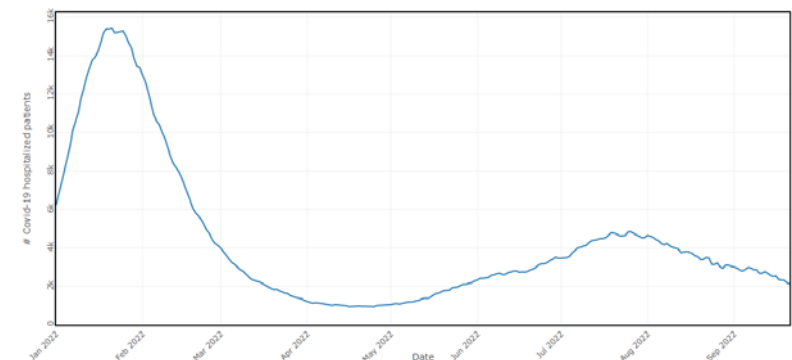

Bivalent boosters recommended for 12+.

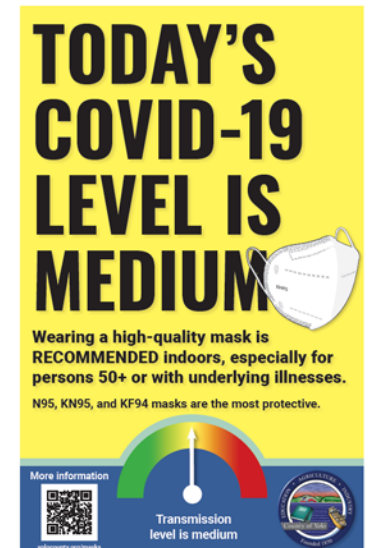
- Moderna and Pfizer have developed bivalent boosters that target Omicron (BA.4/5) and the original SARS-CoV-2 strain
- Will boost waning immunity and offer improved Omicron protection
- Recommended for 12+ years, 2 months after latest dose
- ~9,000 residents have received bivalent boosters to date

CDPH updates Orders and masking guidance.

- Unvaccinated school, healthcare, adult care, and correctional workers no longer required to test regularly if no symptoms
- Masking no longer strongly recommended indoors for all; now aligned with CDC COVID-19 Community Levels

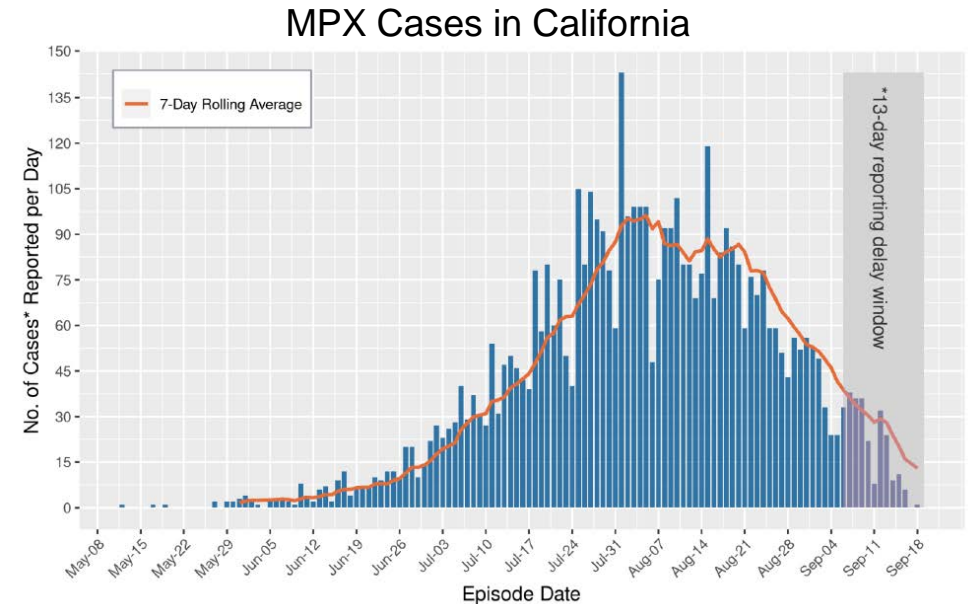

- Masks still required for all in healthcare settings
- Masks optional in shelters and correctional settings in Low



Monkeypox (MPX) outbreak slowing.

- 4,753 cases in California, 5% hospitalized
- 8 cases in Yolo County; none for 2 weeks
- Overall MPX risk is low
- Avoid physical contact with persons who are ill or have unexplained rash; don't share food, drink, clothing, linens; wash your hands
- Vaccines available through providers for persons at increased risk



Get vaccinated against influenza.

- Flu season begins in November
- Vaccination recommended by mid-October
- Vaccination recommended annually for all 6 months and older
- Flu vaccine and COVID booster can be given at same time
- Vaccines available through healthcare providers, retail pharmacies, and County-run clinics
