

RESPONSE AND TRAINING

- ▶ **Emergency Operations Center**

- ▶ Management (Administration/Director),
- ▶ Planning and Intelligence,
- ▶ Operations,
- ▶ Logistics,
- ▶ Finance and Administration (Cost Accounting)

- ▶ **Training**

- ▶ Provide competent EOC staff to support incidents and align with the National Qualification System (NQS) and California EOC Position Credentialing Programs.



PLANNING

- ▶ **Emergency Operations Plan(s)**

- ▶ Intended to facilitate multi-jurisdictional and interagency coordination in emergency.

- ▶ **Fire Response**

- ▶ Yolo County Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) – hazard mitigation plan specific to wildfire.

- ▶ **Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP)**

- ▶ Due December 2023
- ▶ Required for access to FEMA Dollars.
- ▶ Significant amount of work – Identifies and evaluates specific local hazard mitigation strategies to be considered.
- ▶ Options
 - ▶ Internal Staff
 - ▶ Consultant
