**Authorize the Acceptance of Grant Funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$51,016**

**WHEREAS**, the Yolo County District Attorney applied for and received grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program. These funds will be utilized in the High-Tech Crimes Unit to become an accredited lab; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has made available funding for the grant period of April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services awarded the Yolo County District Attorney \$51,016 for the duration of the grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Board authorizes the Yolo County District Attorney and/or Chief Deputy District Attorney, on its behalf, to execute the grant award agreement, including any amendments or extension necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. The Board understands and agrees that neither the Board of Supervisors nor the District Attorney may use any grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
