# Disproportional **IMPACT** of homelessness

1

Seek greater equity based on race, ethnicity, behavioral health, age or other 'protected' status

2

Reduce overrepresentation of Blacks and Native Americans for those experiencing homelessness

3

Help those over 55 years, with disabilities, and with behavioral health concerns obtaining and retaining housing

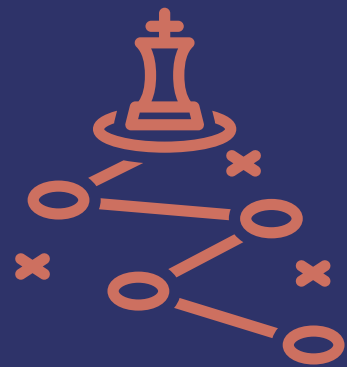

## Plan to Address Homelessness



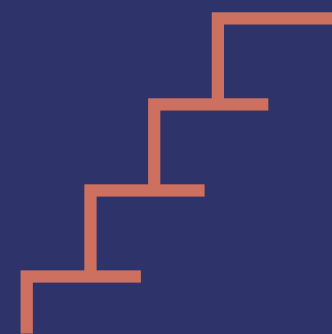
The Plan was created in 2019

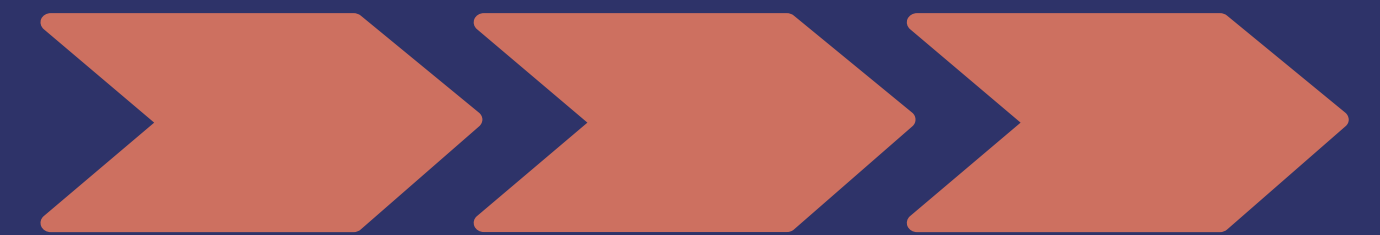


Outreach via surveys and interviews of stakeholders
