Definition Update

Electronic Smoking Device

“Electronic smoking device” means any device that may be used to deliver any aerosolized or vaporized substance to the person inhaling from the device, including, but not limited to, an e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe, vape pen, or e-hookah. **Electronic smoking device includes any component, part, or accessory of the device, and also includes any substance that may be aerosolized or vaporized by such device, whether or not the substance contains nicotine.** Electronic smoking device does not include drugs, devices, or combination products authorized for sale by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, as those terms are defined in the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

Smoking

“Smoking” means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted or heated cigar, cigarette, or pipe, or any other lighted or heated product containing, made, or derived from nicotine, tobacco, marijuana, or other plant, **whether natural or synthetic,** that is intended for inhalation. “Smoking” includes using an electronic smoking device.

Tobacco Product Pricing & Packaging

Prohibition of Tobacco Coupons and Discounts

No retailer shall:

- honor or redeem coupons
- sell any tobacco product to a consumer through a multiple-package discount

Minimum Package

- Little Cigars must be sold in package of at least 5
- Any Cigar unless it is sold in a package of at least 5; however shall not apply to a cigar that is priced at least \$7

Minimum Price

- Cigarettes \$9 per package of 20
- Little Cigars \$9 per package of 5
- Cigars \$7 per cigar

Smoke Free Multi-Unit Residences

“Multi-unit Residence” means a property containing two or more units, including, but not limited to, apartment buildings, condominiums, duplex, and triplex.

Policy Options

Least Restrictive

10 Apartment Complexes

- 5 HUD properties
- 5 Privately owned
 - 2 have voluntary no smoking policy

Most Restrictive*

116 Properties

- 78 Dwelling, multi-family
 - apartments
 - condos
- 38 Dwelling, two-family or duplex

**44 municipalities require all MUH properties with 2 or more units to be 100% smokefree indoors—both rental units and condominium/owner-occupied units*

Enforcement

Complaint driven

individuals exposed to secondhand smoke as a result of a violation of this policy may initiate enforcement by registering a complaint with the County of Yolo

Administrative penalties shall not be imposed unless the individual in violation has received **at least three written warnings** given resources to cessation services.

- A \$100 fine upon finding the first violation within any three-year period.
- A \$200 fine upon finding a second violation within any three-year period.
- A \$500 fine upon finding a third or subsequent violation within any three-year period.
