WORKGROUPS

- Workgroups created for the priority categories (Mental Health, Community Parks & Facilities, Child, Youth & Families, Food Security, Housing & Homeless)
- Workgroups meet to discuss projects

2

BOARD LIAISON MEETING

- The workgroup lead, along with the CAO Liaison, meets with the Board Liaisons for the workgroup
- Workgroup lead presents projects to Board Liaisons

3

FULL BOARD PRESENTATION

- After the Board Liaison meeting, the Workgroup lead presents both the Workgroup and the Board Liaison Recommendations to the Full Board for consideration at the subsequent BOS meeting

4

STAFF BEGIN CONTRACTS

- Once the full Board approves the workgroup's project recommendations, staff will begin creating the contracts with the recipients.

5

CONTRACTS BACK TO BOARD

- As contracts are completed, Staff bring the contracts back to the Board on consent agenda.

6

PROJECT PERFORMANCE

- As projects begin and move along, Staff will reach out to remind recipients of project compliance; performance reports and invoicing.
