

RESOLUTION NO. 22-_____

A Resolution Increasing the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget for the Innovation and Technology Department by \$500,000 for the Local Agency Technical Assistance Grant.

WHEREAS, the Budget Act of 2021 and Senate Bill 156 allocation \$6 billion to build out broadband networks in California’s unserved/underserved areas; and

WHEREAS, as part of that \$6 billion investment the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has authorized a total of \$50 million in funds for technical assistance under a new tribal and local agency technical assistance (LATA) grant program; and

WHEREAS, on August 29, 2022 Yolo County applied for a LATA Grant in the amount of \$500,000 through the CPUC and was notified on October 17, 2022 that the grant had been approved; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2021, by Resolution No. 21-117, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors authorized executing the Golden State Connect Authority (GSCA) Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement for Yolo County to join the GSCA JPA as a member county for the purpose of expanding broadband access and quality in Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, the 2022-23 Budget for Yolo County, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on September 27, 2022, does not include appropriations related to the LATA grant; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to amend the budget for fiscal year 2022-2023 as follows:
