Resolution No. 22-144

Resolution Recognizing Congresswoman Matsui for Securing American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021 the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide continued relief from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$350 billion of ARPA funding was allocated to assist state, local, tribal and territory governments in responding to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds provide needed fiscal relief for recipients that have experienced revenue loss due to the onset of the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, Treasury presumes that up to \$10 million in revenue has been lost due to the public health emergency and recipients are permitted to use that amount (not to exceed the award amount) to fund "government service; "and

WHEREAS, these ARPA funds will provide a significant one-time, supplemental resource for our county government to use for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yolo received approximately \$42.8 million from the federal government related to this program; and

WHEREAS, Congress and the Yolo County Board of Supervisors collaborated to ensure that all sectors receive critical assistance.

WHEREAS, the County of Yolo is committed to using the opportunity created by the ARPA funds to uplift, support, and improve the quality of life for all members of our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby expresses its gratitude and recognizes Congresswoman Matsui for his support and numerous efforts in allocating funds benefitting the people from Yolo County.
