

RESOLUTION NO. _____

(Resolution Increasing the DA’s FY22/23 Budget by \$65,000)

WHEREAS, new laws passed by the California legislature have created the need for training of investigation staff in the Yolo County District Attorney’s Office in juvenile interrogation and a research partner to collect statistical data and reporting from the DA case management system; and

WHEREAS, the funding for training and the research partner were not included in FY22/23 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase appropriation and estimated revenue in the DA Seized Assets (12553120514920) in the amount of \$65,000 due to funding from federal seized assets and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in fiscal year 2022-2023 as follow:


