Resolution No. 22-154

Recognizing the Contributions of Hoa Tan to Yolo County

WHEREAS, cannabis licensing and regulation procedures are a relatively new development in county governance; and

WHEREAS, the cannabis market has undergone significant changes since Yolo County implemented its first regulatory ordinance dealing with cannabis in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Hoa Tan has demonstrated distinguished service to Yolo County for over a decade, including more than three years working on cannabis-related issues; and

WHEREAS, Hoa Tan has served as the Yolo County Cannabis Program Manager since September 2022; and

WHEREAS, in his capacity as Cannabis Program Manager, Hoa Tan has transformed the way Yolo County cannabis regulation and licensing is conducted; and

WHEREAS, Hoa Tan has worked to create the first electronic checklist formatted cannabis inspection form in the State of California, allowing for an easy to understand and easy to submit inspection process; and

WHEREAS, Hoa Tan has created a revolutionary “Metric Summary Report Template” to easily track and summarize cannabis inventory information, allowing for greater oversight and reducing costs of field inspections; and

WHEREAS, automated systems developed by Hoa Tan have resulted in many operational improvements, including cutting staff time cost for inspections by up to 88% on average, greater reliability in data collection, and substantial ongoing cost savings to the County; and

WHEREAS, these improvements have made Yolo County a statewide leader in cannabis oversight and provided a template for counties across California to reduce costs and increase oversight in their own cannabis regulating efforts; and

WHEREAS, Hoa Tan has provided his assistance to replicate his cannabis regulation program in localities statewide free of charge, saving local governments thousands of dollars every year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize, commend, and thank Hoa Tan for his exemplary service to Yolo County and to the State of California.
