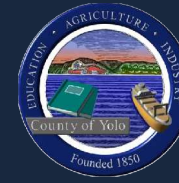

Created a Policy on Emergency Communication for the Board of Supervisors.

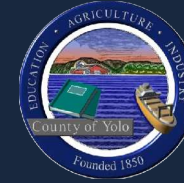


Internal procedures that outline communication to the Board of Supervisors of potential planned, actual, non-emergent, or emergent events of significant local and/or regional interest.

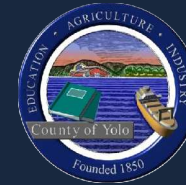
Emergency Operation Center

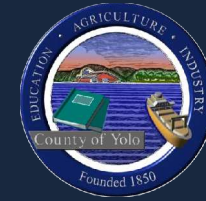


Re-establish Disaster Service Council



Acts as an advisory body, providing guidance and recommending priorities for the Yolo County Office of Emergency Services.

Emergency Communication



The formation of this council would ensure a comprehensive emergency management system that uses a Whole Community Approach and is fully inclusive of individual needs and circumstances.

Advise on major plans, policies, resources, training, and government and non-government relations issues around emergency management (Protect, Mitigate, Response, Recover)

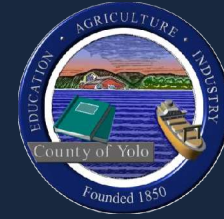


Approve Board Emergency Communication Policy.
