Base Costs should include the following:
 All labor associated with set-up, take-down, surveying, unloading, processing, labeling, transportation, fuel, PPE, general supplies, duct tape, drums, buckets, labels, etc.

Cost Per Week:
\$ 4,449.60

*Price is for times proposed in RFP and includes 4 people on Friday and 5 people on Saturday. Each additional staff would be charged \$499 per day.
 *Alternate schedule of 3 staff, 3 days per week available as outlined in Technical Response.

All designated staff shall be onsite from 6:30 am - 4:30 pm every Friday and Saturday. Site prep and bulking occurs from 6:30 - 7:30, collection program is open to public from 7:30 am - 3:30 pm, final sorting, labeling, storage, site-walk and cleanup occurs from 3:30-4:30 pm. CONTRACTOR staff is to be offsite by 4:45 pm each day. Any overtime costs incurred by the CONTRACTOR shall be at the expense of the CONTRACTOR and not the COUNTY and should be included in this weekly rate to cover travel time to and from the PHHWF. (See further detail in RFP and Sample Agreement)

(3) As part of these services the debris and liquid waste collected must be disposed of at the Yolo County Central Landfill via the COUNTY liquid waste acceptance program. Standard Pricing Conditions:

- Pricing is based on the information provided and will be confirmed following receipt of a completed waste profile. All pricing is pending profile approval and/or waste sample analysis.
- A minimum charge of \$350 applies to all invoices.
- All invoices are subject to applicable Federal, State, and local taxes & fees.
- E-Manifest Fee of \$25 will be applied
- In order to offer the safest and most complete services, we may need to apply price adjustments as necessary to cover costs that are beyond our control such as extraordinary or unexpected increases in disposal costs, regulatory changes, economic changes, war, etc.

Waste Specific Conditions

- Disposal prices for gas cylinders are for those with original label, operable valve and in acceptable DOT shipping condition.
 - Unknown identification fee of \$350 may be charged for each unknown gas that is sampled and analyzed
 - A confirmation fee of \$200 may be charged for each suspected gas that requires confirmation due to lack of original label. If results do not match suspected contents, then unknown ID rate will apply along with additional disposal costs if applicable.
 - Inoperable valve fee: No charge for Category A cylinders. For Categories B thru E, a tapping fee of \$350 per cylinder will apply regardless of size of cylinder. For categories F & G, inoperable valve fee will be Case-by-Case.
