

I. General Company Information

A. Company Overview

Professional Logistic Services (PLS) was formed in 2012. It was originally a subsidiary of Appliance Distribution which was formed in 1999 and one of the first companies in California to receive the Certified Appliance Recycling (CAR) license. We worked closely with DTSC in creating the criteria for being certified as an experienced and responsible recycler of used appliances. PLS provides recycling services for large and small retailers, delivery companies and installers of household appliances. We primarily recycle about 80% of all incoming appliances while exporting "as is" used appliances to customers in Mexico. We have over 23 years of experience in the appliance recycling field. We are family owned and operated locally in Sacramento, California. We are also a certified MBE.

B. Describe your agency's background and depth of ability to ensure services are provided, including:

1. Total number of employees: **11**
2. A description of your agency's business structure, including an organized chart, and names and descriptions of key personnel, who will be assigned to provide services. **We are a small business located in Sacramento. We are an S-Corp with one stock holder which is the owner/President, Roy Fernandez. Roy is involved in the day to day operations. Also is Carmen Fernandez who is Roy's aunt and longtime employee (22 year) of the company. She is the office manager handling payables and receivables and handles all paperwork. Marco Espinosa is the warehouse manager who has been with the company also for 22 years. Marco handles the daily work load and coordination of all logistics. Below Marco we have two employees who have been with the company for 20 years and two other who have over 15 year's experience. Our workforce is well trained and experienced in safety, appliance recycling and DOT regulations.**
3. The nearest service location to the County: **We are located 20 min away at 901 North B St. Sacramento, CA 95811, our location is a 25,000 sq. ft. warehouse with several dock doors and a full recycling line to handle over 125 refrigerated units daily.**

II. Experience

A. Vendor Minimum Qualifications

1. Describe your experience working in the appliance servicing field for 5 years or more.

PLS (Appliance Distribution previously) has over 22 years' experience in the appliance logistics and recycling field. We have worked with such companies as Montgomery Wards, Circuit City, Home Depot, Lowes, Sears, Costco, RC Willey, GE, Best Buy, SMUD, PG&E, City of Sacramento, SCE, Roseville Electric, Waste Management, Amazon and many more smaller retailers and utilities across the US. We have provided both recycling services of appliances and logistics or both to these companies. Roy Fernandez was instrumental working with DTSC to form the CAR program with DTSC spending several months in our warehouse reviewing processes used to create the proper recycling of appliances. PLS has scaled back its total workforce to operating solely in Northern CA. We currently have a fleet of four 26' foot enclosed bobtail trucks with a one semi-truck along with six 53" foot enclosed trailers. PLS is considered a "one stop shop" for companies appliance recycling needs as we provide logistics complete with self-loading, recycling and documentation all from one shop. We work with both Schnitzer Steel and Sims Metals as they both receive processed appliances from us.

B. Vendor Minimum Requirements

Describe how you meet the minimum requirements

1. Collect, transport, service and recycle all major appliances listed in this agreement either directly or through partnerships with a third-party recycler
PLS is a "one stop shop". We have our own fleet of trucks to provide daily pick up at the county landfill. A crew of 2 men will be able to arrive daily and load the truck with all appliances listed in the agreement. All appliances will be secured in the truck and brought back to the Sacramento warehouse where it will be sorted and processed. PLS currently process about 1000 appliances daily in our 25,000 sq. foot warehouse. We have a recycling line for refrigerators processing easily 125-150 daily in one shift. Once the appliances are processed, they are loaded on to our own trucks and sent to either Schnitzer Steel or Sims Metal. The whole process is done in-house including documentation and counts needed. The County will not have to sort material, load or touch any of the product. Our crews will count each type of appliance loaded and provide the county a count prior to leaving.
2. Provide required reporting documents to County to verify CAR compliance for each major appliance collected from YCCL.
PLS used FORM 1430 required by DTSC when delivering to the scrap facilities. PLS also uses various forms to keep counts of each unit picked up from vendors. PLS is open to using whatever documented form required by YCCL in its daily count. We will also keep track of recycled hazardous materials including amounts of refrigerant, oil, PCB's and mercury switches removed from any appliances collected at YCCL.

C. Additional Qualifications and Evidence of Experience

1. ***Project Organization:*** Provide a concise description of how the PROPOSER's firm intends to organize and implement its approach to the project.
PLS will dedicate a truck daily to arrive at YCCL to load any and all appliances listed in Exhibit D. A crew of two men will arrive each morning to load and count each specific type of appliance and load into its truck. The count can be verified by an YCCL employee and signed off. A copy of the count will be left with YCCL daily. The appliances will be brought back to Professional Logistic Services in Sacramento where it will be sorted and processed. All appliances from YCCL will be marked specifically to track removal of all hazardous material. Once appliances are processed, they will then be loaded on to one of PLS's trucks where it will be shipped to either Schnitzer Steel in Rancho Cordova or Sim's Metal located across the street from our facility. We work with both companies and have for years. They are both familiar with our processes of appliance recycling. Our method will prevent YCCL from having to provide any labor whatsoever for sorting, separating, counting and loading. PLS handles it all. No bins will be required to take up space at the YCCL facility. No work will be performed on-site. These are all benefits to YCCL that they are not seeing now.

Roy Fernandez

Roy is President of PLS and is involved in day to day operations of the contact. Roy will be primary contact for this scope of work. Roy has over 22 years in appliance recycling and is certified as a refrigeration removal tech through AHAM-NARDA.

Carmen Fernandez

Carmen has been the office manager and AP/AR person with the company for over 22 years. She has a vast knowledge of record keeping and will be point of contact for any record keeping.

Marco Espinosa

Marco is the warehouse manager for PLS with over 22 years with the company. He has a vast knowledge in appliance recycling, safety and logistics. Marco controls the day to day operation of the both drive crews and warehouse personnel. He has experience in both refrigerator reclamation and procedures in proper appliance recycling.

Raudel Tehran and Miguel Torres

These two gentlemen have been with the company for over 10 years working the refrigerator recycling line. They have years of experience in reclamation of refrigerant, oil and hazardous materials from all appliances. They also will be tracking amounts of hazardous material removed for all YCCL recycled appliances.

Fausto Lopez and Ramon Ledesma

Fausto has 21 years with PLS and Ramon has 20 years. Both gentlemen have years of experience in handling appliances. These gentlemen will be lead drivers in picking up the daily appliances and logging the quantities of each type of product picked up.

3. *Responsibilities and Duties Definitions:* The PROPOSER shall submit a list of trained staff technicians needed for the program, along with a list of duties and responsibilities of each.

Marco Espinosa

Marco will be responsible for coordinating pick-ups and flow of logistics and recycling of all YCCL product. He will also keep track of paper flow from drivers and technicians keeping track of amounts of hazardous material collected to provide to Carmen Fernandez

Raudel Tehran

Raudel will be responsible for removing all refrigerants from all appliances containing refrigerants. He will also be responsible for collecting all data of amounts of hazardous material removed including: amounts of refrigerants, oils, PCB's, mercury switches, light bulbs. Raudel has 10 years' experience in refrigerant removal.

Miguel Torres

Miguel will assist Raudel on the refrigerator recycling line. His primary function is the removal of oil from compressors of refrigerated items. He also tracks amounts from each unit. Miguel has 18 years of experience in this job and is AHAM-NARDA certified since 2005 for the removal of refrigerants.

4. *Program Staffing:* The PROPOSER shall describe the number of employees that will be onsite each collection week. The PROPOSER shall include staff training certificates for current staff detail staffing levels by job function:
PLS is proposing a different method of scope of work than what is currently being done. We are a one-stop shop that will provide pick up service daily of appliances without YCCL personnel needing to sort or load. We will have a crew of two men daily picking up any and all appliances listed in exhibit D. We will load in to our company truck where appliances will be brought back to PLS warehouse located in Sacramento. All appliances will be processed daily. Once processing has been completed, the processed appliances will then be loaded on to company trucks and delivered to either Schnitzer Steel or Sims Metal. All product amounts will be tracked and all hazardous material removed will be documented and provided to YCCL.
5. *Subcontractors:* List all subcontractors, including transporters, and recycling and hazardous waste disposal facilities to be used to fulfill the obligations of this contract; include licenses and permits. The PROPOSER will arrange for and manage any subcontractors necessary to provide services. Any anticipated subcontractor labor, transportation, or other services to be used must be listed. The PROPOSER will provide information on the background, experience and training. All subcontractors must be trained as set forth in the Agreement. The PROPOSER will describe the level of training required and the role subcontractor will play in the event implementation. This contract may be held by an appliance servicing contractor with the collector, transporter and recycler being the sub or this contract may be held by the collector, transporter and recycler with the appliance servicing company being the sub.
Professional Logistic Services will be performing almost all of the functions needed to perform the scope of work. However, the end product of processed appliances will be sent to either Schnitzer Steel or Sims Metal. We also use outside services to handle all hazardous materials. The companies are listed here:

- 1) **Perfect Score Technologies.** Perfect Score Technologies is a company dealing with recovered refrigerants. They provide PLS 1000lb tanks in which reclaimed refrigerant is stored. Once full, Perfect Score Technologies then collects these tanks for resale.
 - 2) **World Oil Environmental Services.** World Oil collects all compressor oil we collect from refrigerated compressors.
 - 3) **Univar.** Univar handles our PCB's and mercury switches collected.
6. **Hazardous Waste Disposal:** Provide the list of locations hazardous waste is shipped for proper disposal after servicing of appliances.
- 1) **Perfect Score Technologies.** Handlers of recovered refrigerants. Located at 4012 Bronze Way. Dallas, TX 75237.
 - 2) **World Oil Environmental Services.** Collector of compressor oil. Located at 2000 N Alameda Street, Compton CA 90222.
 - 3) **Univar USA.** Collector of mercury switches and PCB capacitors. Located at PO Box 74086, Los Angeles CA 90007.
7. **Safety Performance:** Describe your firms Health and Safety Program and explain how you will be prepared to respond to a spill or release if one occurs.
PLS has a full health and safety program along with a detailed training manual. All employees are trained on handling hazardous material and training is done each quarter to review the policies and procedures. We also hold weekly "tailgate" safety meetings reviewing one subject each week on safety.
PLS has equipment in place in case of any spillage of oil or accidental release of gas in the warehouse.
8. **Record Keeping and Manifest:** Describe procedures that will be used to ensure that all BOL's, CAR certificates, records, and reports are completed and retained according to Federal, State, and local regulations. PROPOSERS are to attach one copy/sample of each form that will be used as part of this agreement.
Being that PLS is located a half a mile from DTSC headquarters, we seem to be inspected regularly. We make sure to keep on file all manifests of hazardous material, form 1430 from DTSC of all processed appliances taken to scrap yards, BOL's from product received and a binder indicating the amounts of refrigerants recovered.
Sample of these are provided.

III. Demonstrated Competence/Responsibility through Compliance History-Exhibit "D"

PLS recently had an inspection by DTSC on October 26, 2022. We get regularly inspected being so close to DTSC headquarters so we make sure to keep up on all requirements. However, we did incur a couple of minor violations but it was more towards the handling of E-waste and not the appliance recycling program. The minor violations were simply needing to change the verbiage of our sign showing where E-waste was stored at our facility. Our sign said "E-Waste" and needed to be changed to say "Universal Waste – Electronic Devices" as this was changed by DTSC. Also we needed to now label each pallet containing E-Waste with the appropriate labeling. This was corrected immediately and submitted with satisfaction to DTSC. Otherwise

PLS does not have any pending/unresolved regulatory issues and we have never been fined.

IV. Labor Impact

PLS will propose a method which could save the COUNTY a significant amount of money by reducing altogether its labor in the handling of appliances received. As stated in previous answers to questions, PLS is a one stop shop.
When customers arrive to drop off appliances, they can unload the product in whatever staging are the COUNTY determines. The COUNTY will not have to sort or stage the appliances whatsoever. PLS crew will arrive daily and load each appliance in to company truck, counting each unit by like. A COUNTY representative can be there to verify the count or have the count prepared prior to PLS arrival. All appliances will be transported to PLS facility located 15 miles away in Sacramento. At the PLS 25,000 sq. ft. facility, the appliances will be unloaded and processed. All hazardous material will be tracked and documented. Once appliances have been processed, they will then be transported by PLS trucks to either Schnitzer Steel or Sims Metal. The COUNTY will no longer need to stage, sort, load into bins, prepare for removal of refrigerant or document. This will be taken care of by PLS.


