

RESOLUTION NO. _____

(Certification-Exception to 180-Day Waiting Period to Enroll a Retiree to CalPERS)

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 21220 provides that a retiree on service, disability, or industrial disability receiving a monthly allowance from CalPERS shall not, except as provided, be employed in any capacity by a CalPERS employer unless the retiree has first been reinstated from retirement; and

WHEREAS, a retiree may work for a CalPERS employer as a limited duration employee (retired annuitant) only as specified in California retirement law; and

WHEREAS, a 180-day waiting period is required for all employees who retire from a CalPERS employer before retirees can return to work for another CalPERS employer without reinstating from retirement, except under certain specified circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors may present CalPERS with a resolution, passed in a public meeting, that approves the appointment of a CalPERS retiree and waives the 180-day waiting period provided the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yolo has hired new staff in the property tax function of the Department of Financial Services, which is complex and detail oriented work; and

WHEREAS, the County retired annuitant the County wishes to bring back has a long history of working on complex property tax functions; and has a long history of working with County property tax functions; and

WHEREAS, the County would benefit from the annuitant assisting in training and aiding with technical duties during a limited period to ensure that property tax function continues uninterrupted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. There exists a critical need to employ a Property Tax staff to assist the Property Tax function of Financial Services, to train and develop staff, and complete time-sensitive property tax functions.
2. The appointment of CalPERS retiree, Sheryl Hardy-Salgado, as a Property Tax support staff is necessary to fill a critically needed position before 180 days have passed.

The Board approves of the appointment of CalPERS retiree, Sheryl Hardy-Salgado as Property Tax support staff to work on property tax matters and to fill a critically needed position before 180 days have passed.
