Reason for Recommended Action/Background

The Board of Supervisors (Board) approves the provision of election services by the Yolo County Registrar of Voters to any city or district that requests said services pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code. The Board also authorizes, under Elections Code section 10400 et seq, the consolidation of local elections that meet applicable legal requirements, including, but not limited to, those set forth in sections 10402 and 10403 of the Elections Code. Cities and districts who request either consolidation or elections services are required to reimburse the County for related costs.

The Board meeting schedule requires an earlier deadline for cities and districts to submit their requests when under the Elections Code; they have until 88 days prior to the election (E-88) to do so. This resolution delegates these authorities to the Registrar of Voters to allow jurisdictions to instead submit paperwork up to and until the legal deadline for each election of E-88.

(Resolution Delegating Authority to Order the Consolidation of Elections)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors desires to provide efficient and effective election administration in Yolo County in accordance with County’s Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board must approve both the provision of election services and the consolidation of elections for cities and districts prior to the finalization of election materials; and

WHEREAS, it is burdensome on cities and districts to need to complete their public process well before statutory deadlines in order to receive Board approval in a timeframe that allows the Registrar of Voters to fully run an election; and

WHEREAS, it will save time and funds for the County, cities and districts if election requests can be decided without delay, thus affording cities and districts the full time specified in state law to submit such requests; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code section 10402 allows the Board to delegate authority to the Registrar of Voters to order the consolidation of local elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code, the Board approves the provision of election services by the Yolo County Registrar of Voters to any city or district that requests said services. Cities and districts shall be required to fully reimburse the County for rendered election-related services.

2. Pursuant to Section 10400 et seq of the Elections Code, the Board authorizes the Yolo County Registrar of Voters to consolidate local elections that meet applicable legal requirements, including, but not limited to, those set forth in sections 10402 and 10403 of the Elections Code. Cities and districts who request consolidation shall reimburse the County for their reasonable share of election-related expenses as determined by the Registrar of Voters.
