RESOLUTION OF THE YOLO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING A MINOR MODIFICATION TO GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY’S ESPARTO LONG-TERM OFF-CHANNEL MINING PERMIT (ZONE FILE #2007-071)

WHEREAS, the County of Yolo (“County”) approved an Off-Channel Mining Permit for aggregate extraction and processing for the Granite Esparto Long-Term Off-Channel Mining Permit (“Esparto Permit”);

WHEREAS, Granite and the County have agreed to a minor modification of Esparto Permit Condition of Approval No. 24; and

WHEREAS, the minor modification to Esparto Permit Condition of Approval No. 24 will not alter the intent of the condition of approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 2. Esparto Permit Condition of Approval No. 24 shall be amended as follows:

24. With the exception of filling in the new terrace area behind the re-graded bank, the applicant shall complete the proposed bank modifications as presented in the approved Streambank Stabilization Plan (SSP), as soon as materials become available, ~~no later than 2021, and/or~~ prior to mining within 700 feet of the adjacent high bank, ~~whichever occurs first~~. The bank stabilization activities shall conform to all applicable provisions of the Cache Creek Resources Management Plan and the Cache Creek Improvement Program.
