**(Resolution Authorizing Acceptance and Execution of Agreement for Access to Technology (ATT) Program administered by the California Department of Aging in the Amount of \$318,366)**

**WHEREAS**, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order (EO) N-73-20 on August 14, 2020 which prioritizes addressing the digital divide that directly impacts older adults; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2021, Governor Newsom signed Assembly Bill (AB) 135 adding Welfare & Institutions Code (WIC) section 9104 which required the CA Department of Aging (“CDA”) to create the Access to Technology (“ATT”) program; and

**WHEREAS**, ATT is a 27-month program to connect older adults and adults with disabilities to technology to help reduce isolation, increase connections, and enhance self-confidence; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 24, 2022, CDA Division of Home and Community Living approved Yolo County’s proposal to receive grant funds for ATT in the amount of \$318,366;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Chair of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors is authorized to accept and execute CDA Agreement AT-2223-57 (“Agreement”) to receive ATT funds in the amount of \$318,366 for the period of October 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024.
2. The Yolo County Procurement Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute any non-financial extensions or amendments to the Agreement upon approval as to form by County Counsel.
3. The Director of the Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to execute any fiscal and program forms and reports required under this Agreement, including forms and reports required under any extensions or amendments thereto.
