

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**(Certification-Exception to 180-Day Waiting Period to Enroll a Retiree to CalPERS)**

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 21220 provides that a retiree on service, disability, or industrial disability receiving a monthly allowance from CalPERS shall not, except as provided, be employed in any capacity by a CalPERS employer unless the retiree has first been reinstated from retirement; and

**WHEREAS**, a retiree may work for a CalPERS employer as a limited duration employee (retired annuitant) only as specified in California retirement law; and

**WHEREAS**, a 180-day waiting period is required for all employees who retire from a CalPERS employer before retirees can return to work for another CalPERS employer without reinstating from retirement, except under certain specified circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors may present CalPERS with a resolution, passed in a public meeting, that approves the appointment of a CalPERS retiree and waives the 180-day waiting period provided the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Yolo elected Assessor must deliver an accurate and timely tax roll by before July 1, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Assessor employs Business Property Specialists to assist in creation, and maintenance of assessments in preparation of the unsecured property tax roll; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. There exists a critical need to employ a/an Assessor/Clerk-Recorder Specialist II staff to assist with the preparation and valuation of business personal property and fixtures for the completion of the 2023/24 unsecured property tax roll.
2. The appointment of CalPERS retiree, Sara Jeska, as a/an Assessor/Clerk-Recorder Specialist II staff is necessary to fill a critically needed position before 180 days have passed.
3. The Board approves of the appointment of CalPERS retiree, Sara Jeska as Assessor/Clerk-Recorder Specialist II staff to work on needed position before 180 days have passed.
