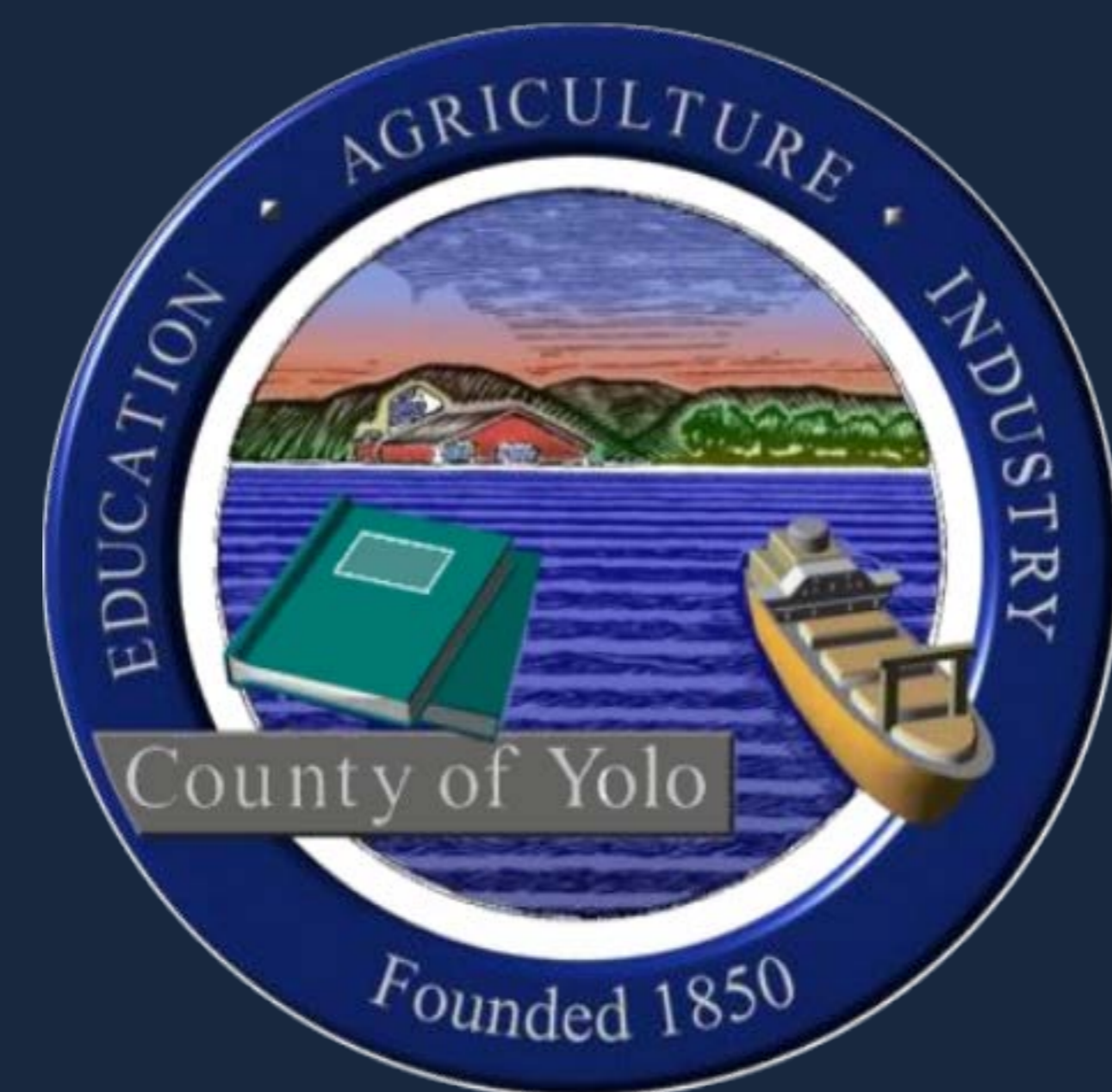

Emergency Communication

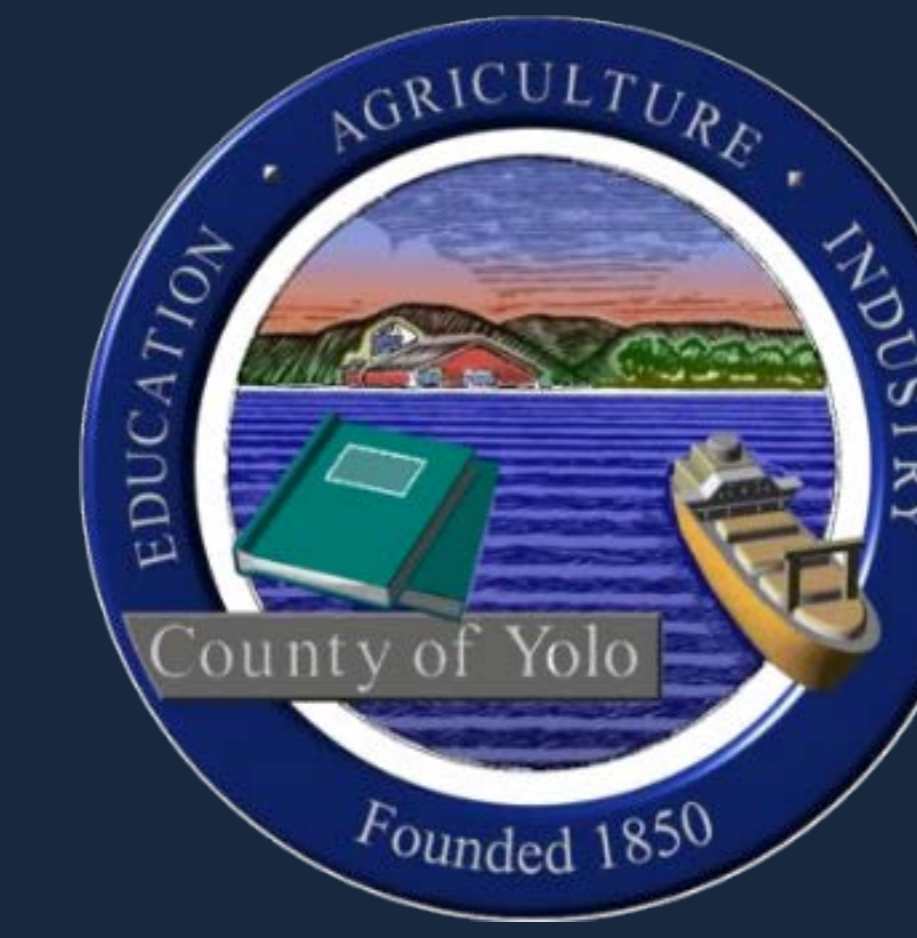


Chapter 1 of Title 4 of the Yolo County Code, Emergency Services. The board approved the emergency service code in March 2007, since then the ordinance has not been updated to reflect the operations, structure, and goal.



The proposed ordinance changes will update language to reflect the re-establishment of the Disaster Service Council and update current emergency services staffing and operations.

Disaster Service Council (DSC)

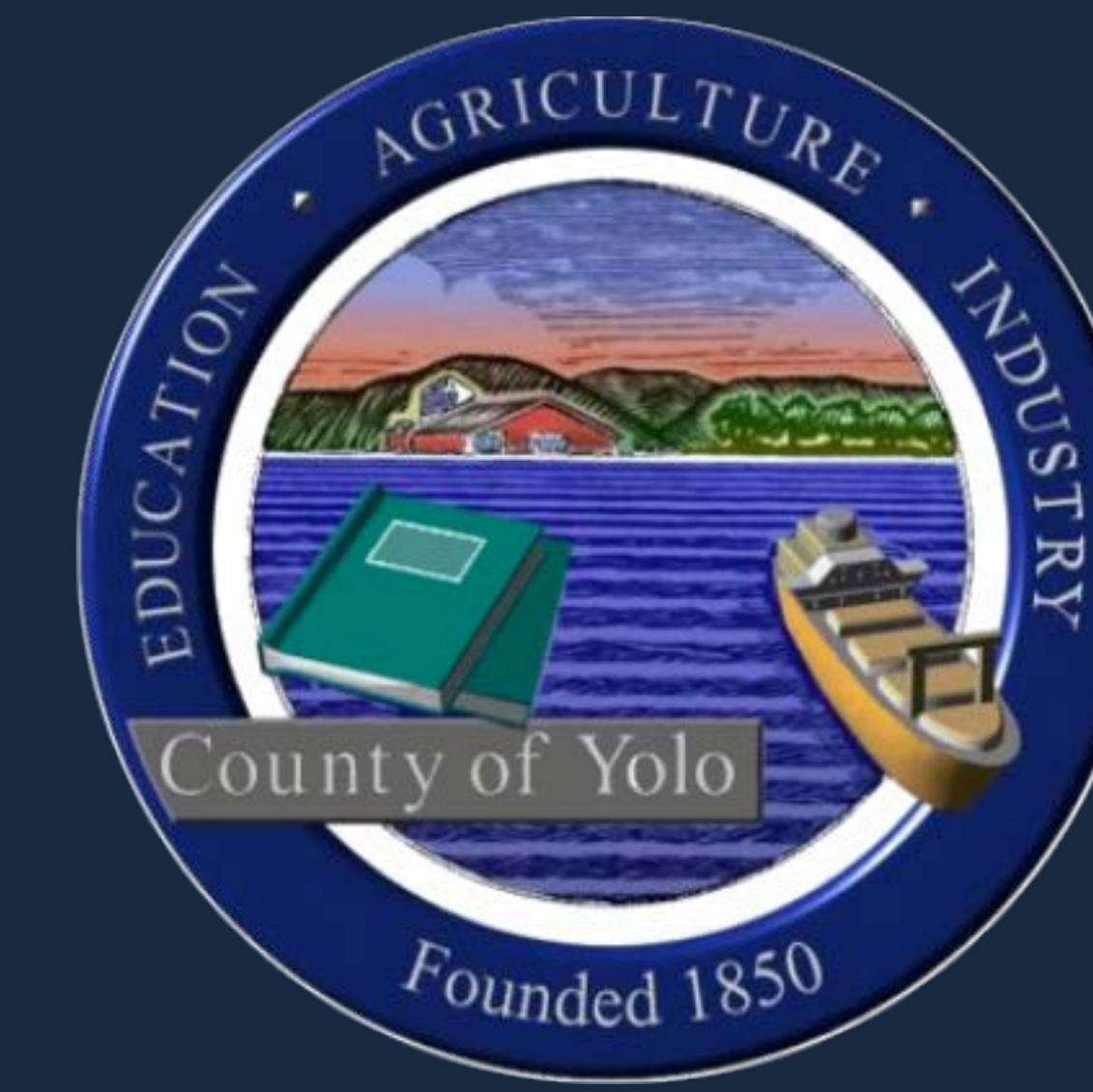


Advise the Office of Emergency Services on disaster preparedness activities and emergency and disaster plans, policies, and procedures.



Review and recommend resolutions, plans, and policies for adoption by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors.

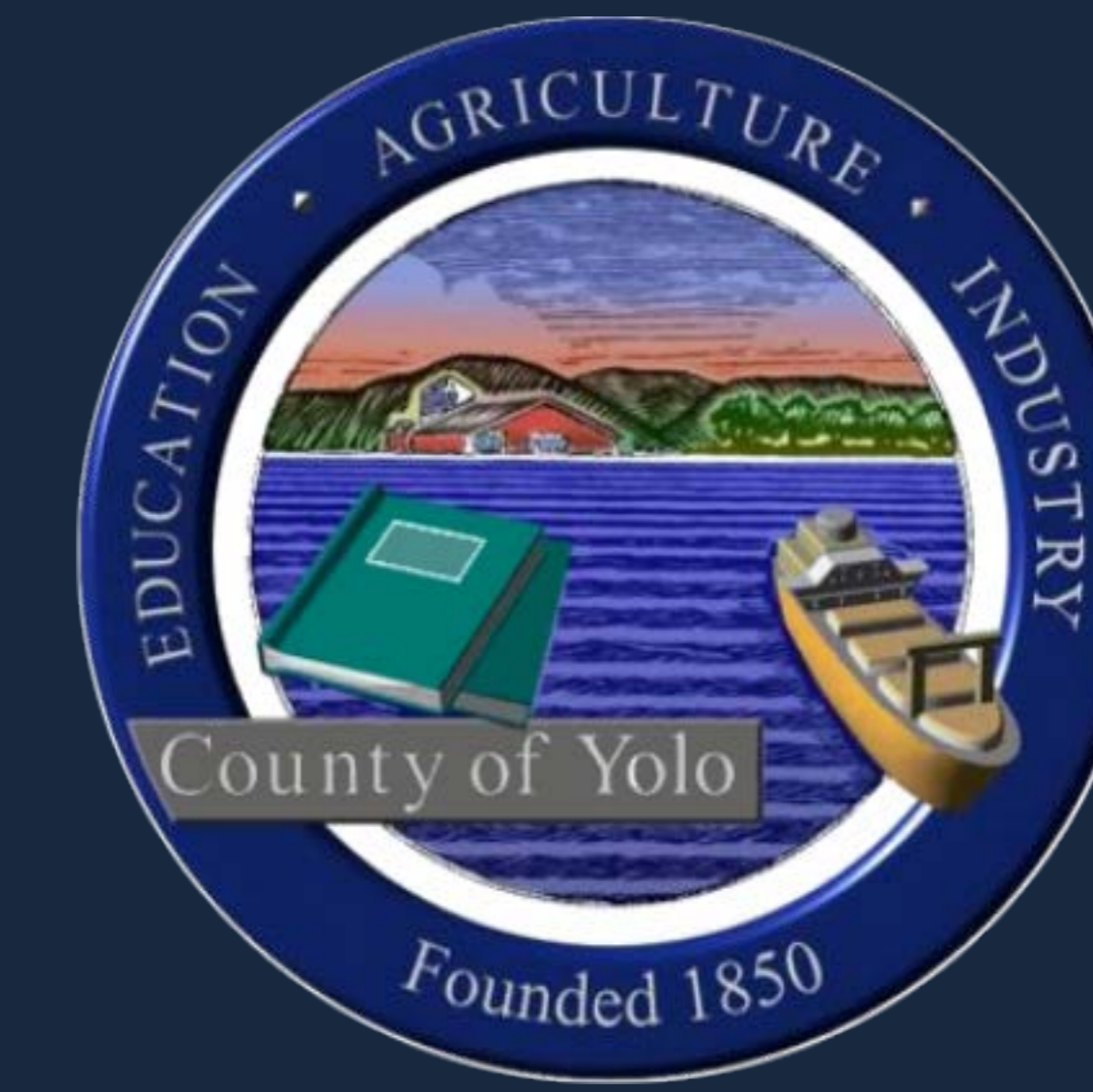

Recommended Actions



Introduce, waive the first reading, receive public comments, and continue to the March 7, 2023, Board of Supervisors meeting for a second reading and adoption of the ordinance amending Chapter 1 of Title 4 of the Yolo County Code regarding emergency services.



These changes, combined, will help to ensure a whole community approach to emergency services and create a safer more resilient Yolo County.
