WHEREAS, during a period of immense transition for the County of Yolo, Sandra stepped up in a transformative fashion, fulfilling the responsibilities of multiple positions in support of the County Administrator’s office, District 4, and the entire county organization; and

WHEREAS, Sandra continues to exemplify the gold standard of public service in her current role as Executive Assistant in the County Administrator’s Office.




