(Resolution Authorizing County to enter into an Agreement with Golden Sierra Job Training Agency for P2E 2.0 Funding)

WHEREAS, since 2018, the California Workforce Development Board (“CWDB”) has awarded \$37 million in state general funds to support regional planning efforts, fund regional plan implementation, and provide resources for direct and supportive services to the formerly incarcerated and other justice-involved individuals; and

WHEREAS, Prison to Employment (“P2E”) 2.0 represents the continuation of the Prison to Employment Initiative; and

WHEREAS, P2E 2.0 funds have been awarded to Regional Planning Units (“RPU”), including the Capital Region RPU, of which County of Yolo (“County”) is a member; and

WHEREAS, Golden Sierra Job Training Agency is the fiscal agent for the Capital Region and is responsible for subcontracting funds; and

WHEREAS, the County, through the Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency (“HHSA”), would like to enter into an agreement with Golden Sierra to receive P2E 2.0 funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. County is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Golden Sierra Job Training Agency to receive P2E funding in the amount of \$100,017 for the period of April 1, 2023 through November 30, 2025 (“Agreement”).
2. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors is approved to execute this Agreement.
3. County Procurement Manager, or designee, is authorized to act on behalf of County to enter into and accept any financial or non-financial amendments and revisions to the Agreement, upon approval as to form by the County Counsel.
4. Authorize the Director of HHSA, or designee, to execute any fiscal and program forms and reports required under this Agreement, including forms and reports required under any extensions or amendments thereto.
