

RESOLUTION NO. _____

(Resolution Authorizing County to enter into an Agreement with Golden Sierra Job Training Agency for RERP funding)

WHEREAS, Regional Equity and Recovery Partnerships (“RERP”) represents an acceleration and deepening of the existing Regional Plan Implementation efforts and supports and invests in partnerships to add high road approaches to existing sector strategies and career pathway programs; and

WHEREAS, “High Road” is a set of economic and workforce development strategies to achieve economic growth, economic equity, shared prosperity, and a clean environment; and

WHEREAS, RERP funds have been awarded to Regional Planning Units (“RPU”), including the Capital Region RPU, of which County of Yolo (“County”) is a member; and

WHEREAS, Golden Sierra Job Training Agency is the fiscal agent for the Capital Region and is responsible for subcontracting funds; and

WHEREAS, the County, through the Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency (“HHSA”), would like to enter into an agreement with Golden Sierra to receive RERP funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. County is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Golden Sierra Job Training Agency to receive RERP funding in the amount of \$109,687.50 for the period of April 14, 2023 through September 30, 2025 (“Agreement”).
2. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors is approved to execute this Agreement.
3. County Procurement Manager, or designee, is authorized to act on behalf of County to enter into and accept any financial or non-financial amendments and revisions to the Agreement, upon approval as to form by the County Counsel.
4. Authorize the Director of HHSA, or designee, to execute any fiscal and program forms and reports required under this Agreement, including forms and reports required under any extensions or amendments thereto.
