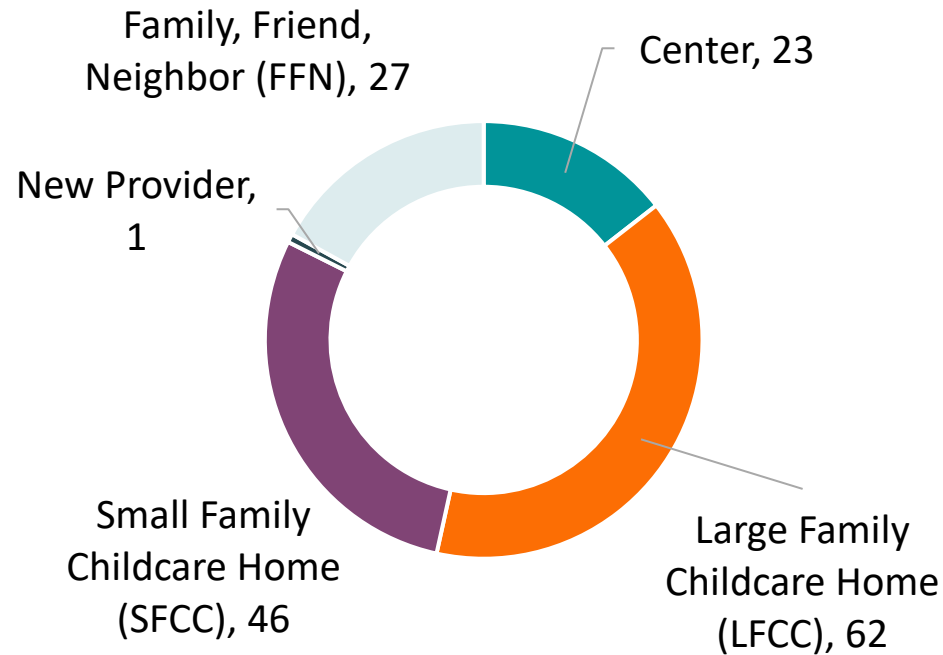




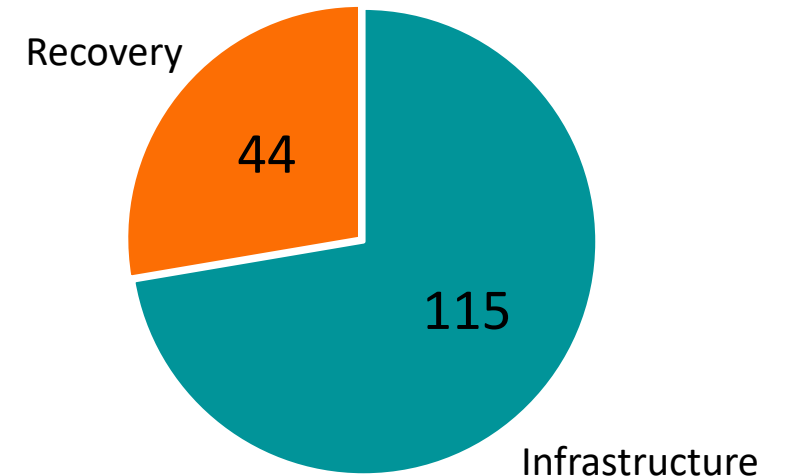

**519** families were enrolled across Yolo County

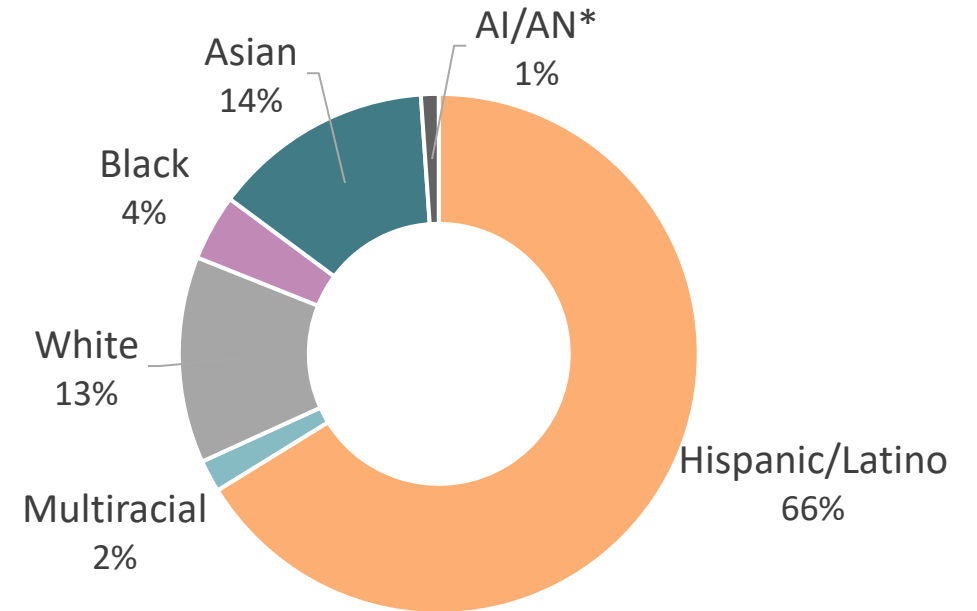
**252** babies were born and received home visits

**44%** of families spoke a primary language that was not English

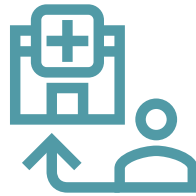

# First Year Impact

**100%** of families were **screened** for depression and anxiety

**1,000+** referrals made to community and healthcare agencies

**98%** of women completed their **postpartum visit**  
(CA MediCal rate = 63%)



**95%** of families received **lactation support**

**100%** of families received Baby Basics **Health Literacy Books**



**97%** of families completed their **newborn and 1-month well-child visit**  
(Yolo County MediCal rate = 62%)

Support for parents, caregivers, and families to provide safe environments and relationships that allow children 0-5 to thrive.



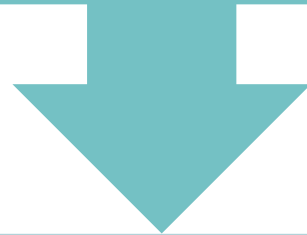
### Quality Early Learning
