Resolution Transferring Appropriations in the Sheriff's Animal Services Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget in the Amount of \$16,991 for the purpose of radio purchase

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has identified a need for additional equipment items to conduct its law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office wishes to purchase two dual-band vehicle radios to fully equip Animal Services Trucks approved as part of the Fiscal Year 2022-23; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests \$16,991 Animal Services budgeted funds to be moved from major object Services and Supplies to major object Equipment for Fiscal Year 2022-23 for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General Fund for Fiscal Year 2022-23 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2022-2023 as follows:
