- Broadband Strategic Plan Update (\$25,000) – Through a partnership with GSFA via an EDA grant, update the Counties 2015 Broadband Strategic Plan.

Project Requests

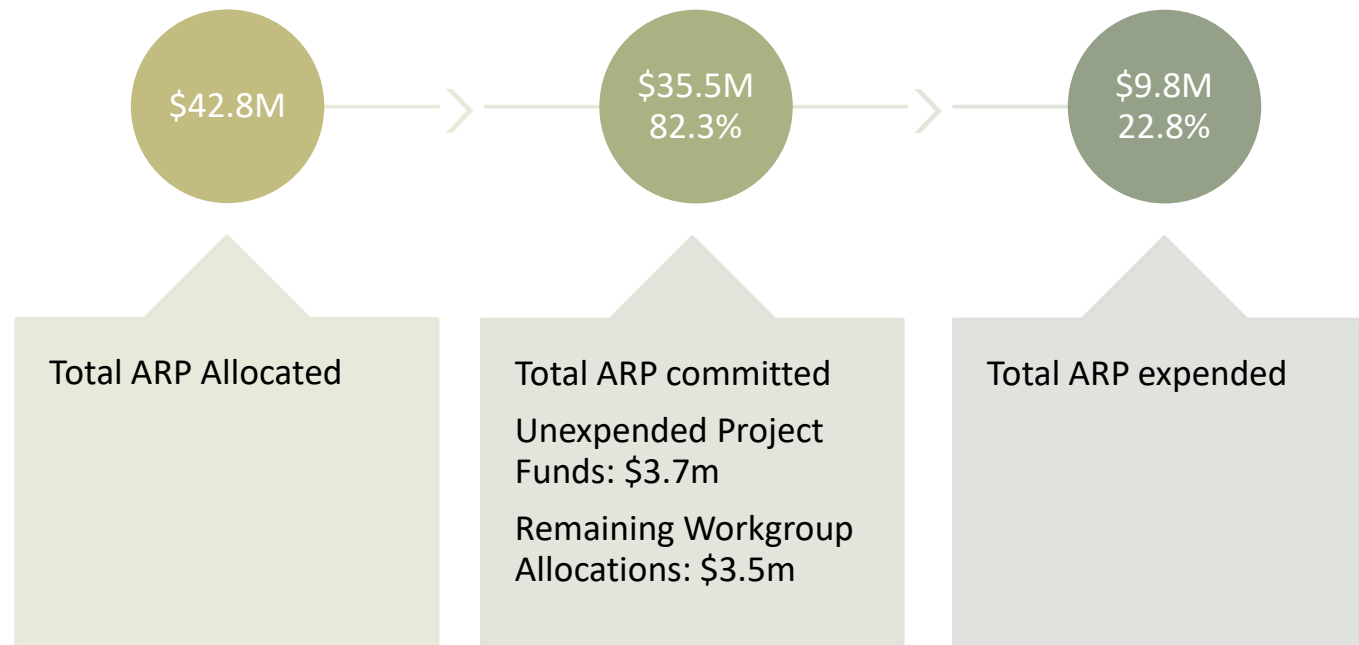
- Guinda Grange Hall (\$3,785.00) – Install High-Speed Broadband and prepay for a year of service to support a recharge-resiliency center.

ARP Quarterly Report: Funding Overview



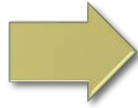
ARP Quarterly Report: Proposed Reallocation

- \$3.7m funding available for reallocation (highlighted in Att. A)
- Department head workgroup reviewed requested allocations, proposes \$2.8m in reallocation
- Reallocation addresses numerous policy priorities (eviction protection funds, additional food security funds, facility improvements)
- Reallocation also proposes \$100k to each supervisorial district as part of community benefit equal allocation plan
