Please approve item #48 regarding the Yolo County Animal Shelter.

It is time to move forward with building a new, state-of-the-art animal shelter and providing important services such as adequate full-time veterinary care for the animals. Towards that end, low cost spay/neuter services must be restored immediately.

Since UC Davis has not provided adequate veterinary service in the past, it is time to look elsewhere and hire a full-time veterinarian who will provide quality care for Yolo County Animal Services.

The Joint Powers Agency (JPA) needs representatives from West Sacramento. For this reason, the Board needs to identify and appoint West Sacramento representatives to the JPA.

Shelter manager Stephanie Amato does an outstanding job in spite of an old, inadequate, and dilapidated facility that is woefully under staffed. For this reason, as well as the above points, it is imperative that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors approve item #48.
