Recommended Changes to Staff Proposal

- ▶ Change 1 -
 - ▶ Better define “emergency” by referring to Public Contract Code
- ▶ Change 2 -
 - ▶ Better define “no apprenticeable trades” by referring to the Labor Code

County JAC Policy Comparisons

	Existing	Proposed
Requirement	Bidder shall be an active member of a JATC or JAC	Contractor must be a signatory to a JATC/JAC or employs apprentices dispatched by a JAC.
Applies to	Construction projects more than \$1m	Public projects as defined in PCC 22002(c) more than \$1M
Maintenance	<silent>	Excluded if meets PCC 22002(d) definition of maintenance
Emergencies	Requirement does not apply during declared emergencies	Requirement does not apply during an emergency or declared emergencies
Other Exemptions	<silent>	Does not apply when 1) there is no apprenticable trade, 2) during a re-bid if there are no responsive bids, 3) prevented by funding source (e.g. federal)
Documentation	Submit proof with bid (in practice a state form DAS-7)	Submit with bid 1) county form certifying meeting JAC requirement and 2) letter from JAC.
Apprenticeship Violation Certification	<silent>	Submit with bid county form declaring no apprenticeship violation in the past three years
