**Resolution No. 23-129**

***Proclaiming the week of September 18-24, 2023, as National Diaper Awareness Week in Yolo County***

**WHEREAS**, one in three families in our county experience diaper need, the condition of not having a sufficient supply of clean diapers to ensure that infants and toddlers are clean, dry and healthy; and

**WHEREAS**, National Diaper Need Awareness Week is a signature initiative of the National Diaper Bank Network that provides individuals, organizations, communities, and elected officials the opportunity to engage in real talk and simple actions to eliminate diaper need; and

**WHEREAS**, Yolo Diaper Bank was established in 2018 by a group of community volunteers to help end diaper need in our communities and has distributed over 300,000 diapers to agency partners in the past five years; and

**WHEREAS**, by working together we can ensure that all babies have access to clean diapers and other basic necessities required for them to thrive and reach their full potential.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the week of September 18 – 24, 2023 to be National Diaper Need Awareness Week in Yolo County, California.
