Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff's Small and Rural Local Law Enforcement Funds Fiscal Year 2023-24 Recommended Budget in the Amount of \$237,774 for the Purpose of Purchasing Body Worn Cameras

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff's Office has identified a need to deploy body worn cameras to ensure transparency and accountability in the delivery of law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office wishes to purchase 60 body worn cameras, hardware, and subscription software necessary to operate the system; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests \$237,774 of Small and Rural Local Law Enforcement Fund Balance to be moved to major object Services and Supplies in the Cost Center Small and Rural Local Law Enforcement Fund for Fiscal Year 2023-24 for the purchase of the body worn camera system;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the budget for fiscal year 2023-24 as follows:
