Resolution Increasing Appropriations in the Sheriff’s Marine Patrol Fiscal Year 2023-24 Budget in the Amount of \$31,546 and Authorize the Sheriff’s Office Signature Authority

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Sheriff’s Office desires to participate in the California State Department of Parks and Recreation’s (State) Law Enforcement Equipment Grant Program to purchase miscellaneous equipment to support or conduct boating safety and boating law enforcement activities; and

WHEREAS, the State Division of Boating and Waterways made available Law Enforcement Equipment Grant funding for the 2023-24 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the California State Parks Department has approved an application for \$31,546 in grant funding from the Sheriff’s Office for the purchase of a replacement inflatable watercraft, trailer, outboard motor, and accessories; and

WHEREAS, said monies were not included in appropriations and estimated revenue of the Sheriff’s Marine Patrol Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-24; and

WHEREAS, there would be no net fiscal impact to the County General fund for fiscal year 2023-24 by making these adjustments; and

WHEREAS, the State requires that the board resolution authorize the signatory of the grant agreement.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Office designates Tom A. Lopez, Yolo County Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator, to have signature authority on all program-related documents.

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the California Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to adjust the 2023-24 fiscal year budget as follows:
