

**FOURTH AMENDMENT
(BOS AGREEMENT NO. ____-____)**

This Fourth Amendment to Agreement No. 22-172 (“Fourth Amendment”) is made and entered into as of the last date signed below, by and between the County of Yolo, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), and California Forensic Medical Group, a California corporation authorized to do business in the State of California (“Contractor”), jointly referred to as the “Parties” herein and who agree as stated below.

WHEREAS, on or about August 5, 2022, the Parties entered into Agreement No. 22-172 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, on or about December 6, 2022, the Parties amended the Agreement via the First Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on or about MMM DD, YYYY, the Parties further amended the Agreement via the Second Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on or about MMM DD, YYYY, the Parties further amended the Agreement via the Third Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Parties would now like to amend the Agreement to as previously amended to:

1. Revise **Section 2.** to extend to the term of the Agreement through October 31, 2023; and
2. Revise **Section 4.** to add funding in the amount of \$256,648.19 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 for a new contract maximum of \$1,306,350.74; and
3. Revise **Paragraph I.B. of Exhibit B** to extend the budget term through June 30, 2023 and reflect the additional funding and new contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Section 2.** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. TERM

This Agreement shall begin upon execution by both Parties and shall remain in full force and effect from March 1, 2022 at 12:01 A.M. through October 31, 2023 at 11:59 P.M., unless sooner terminated as provided herein.

2. **Section 4.** of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

4. COMPENSATION

The maximum amount payable by County under this Agreement is **ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FOUR CENTS (\$1,306,350.74)**. Contractor agrees to perform all services required by this Agreement for an amount not to exceed such maximum dollar amount. The rates and costs shall be as set forth in Exhibit B, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

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3. Paragraph I.B. of Exhibit B to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Amendments to the budget, including, but not limited to, shifting the allocation of funds between categories of services, must be mutually agreed upon in writing. Contractor shall provide a revised budget to the Health and Human Services (HHS) Director for approval.
