JOINT APPRENTICESHIP COMMITTEE PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATION

The County has adopted a Joint Apprenticeship Committee (JAC) participation requirement for certain public projects estimated to cost more than one-million dollars (\$1,000,000). A JAC means an apprenticeship program comprised of an equal number of employer and employee representatives approved by the State of California Division of Apprenticeship Standards. This JAC requirement is in addition to the apprenticeship requirements of the Prevailing Wage Laws.

**To satisfy the County’s JAC participation requirement, Contractors must submit evidence satisfactory to the Procurement Manager or the Procurement Manager’s designee that they participate in a JAC by being a signatory to a JAC or employ registered apprentices dispatched by a JAC. Such evidence may be in the form of a signed letter from a JAC confirming the Contractor is a signatory to a JAC or has hired registered apprentices who are active participants of a JAC.**

By signing below, Contractor acknowledges the County’s JAC participation requirement and certifies that it satisfies this requirement. Failure to submit this form and attach evidence of compliance with this requirement shall result in a determination that the bid is non-responsive.
